For many centuries, cemeteries were commonly found in churchyards. However, in the crowded urban communities of today, this is no longer practical. A modern alternative is the Columbarium, which allows church members and their families to have their enduring resting place in the shadow of the Church. It fulfills the Church's mission to oversee the spiritual life of the congregation from baptism through life, to death.




The fee for a niche *will not* include the urn (s) or cover the cost of cremation. Urns *must* meet the dimensions stated in the purchase contract.

The fee *will* include the plaque inscribed with name and dates of birth and death, the opening and closing of the niche for inurnment, and perpetual care. Each niche is designed to hold two urns.

Niche assignments are allocated in accordance with the desires of each applicant on a first-come, first served basis.

Members of St. John's and their immediate family are entitled to purchase niches as individual inurnment places. The purchase of a niche offers families the benefit of making arrangements without the pressure of time.

What you are Investing in:

Each niche can hold up to two urns, The niche will have plaques inscribed with name and dates of birth and death. St. John's will maintain a fund to ensure the columbarium's perpetual care.
