What We're Doing Right

Our website is designed with both people and accessibility standards in mind. Here's how we're making sure everything feels easy, functional, and inclusive:

VISUAL ACCESSIBILITY

- We use colors that play nicely together — high contrast and easy to read, even on a bright day or low-vision screen.
- Color isn't the only way we get a point across — we use text, shapes, and patterns too.
- We've tested for color vision differences to make sure our palette works for everyone.
- Text scales up gracefully if you need to zoom in or adjust your display — no cut-off words or weird layout jumps.

MOBILE & RESPONSIVE DESIGN

- Whether you're on a phone, tablet, or computer, and no matter how you hold it, our content shows up cleanly and clearly.

KEYBOARD & NAVIGATION

- You can move through our site easily with just a keyboard — no mouse required.
- It's always clear where you are thanks to visual cues and logical focus order.
- Page titles make sense, and links are clearly labeled so there are no surprises about where they'll take you.

CODE & STRUCTURE
