That new perspective made the whole process feel a little more manageable—like finally learning that the garden will grow at its own pace regardless, even if I can’t always see it happening.

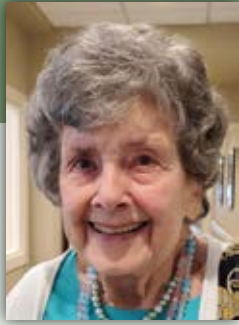
