

A WOMAN ROOTED IN RESILIENCE**

We are honored to share the story of Claire Alison

Jordan Connor — a woman whose life reflects resilience, devotion, and unwavering determination. Born in Oregon City, Oregon, Claire was the third of twelve children and shares her birthday with her twin sister, Chloe, who arrived just eleven minutes later. She grew up primarily in Colorado, where her parents owned a restaurant and cooked for their large family. It was there Claire developed her love of cooking and the skills she still treasures today. Later, the family moved to northwest Washington, where summers were spent picking strawberries and raspberries to earn school clothes and spending money — an experience that instilled in her a strong work ethic at an early age.

In 2021, Claire and Steve moved to Vero Beach to be near her older sister. After Steve suffered a stroke, Claire lovingly became his primary caregiver. Then on July 9, 2025, Claire experienced a stroke herself, affecting her left side — especially challenging for someone who is left-handed. Following Steve’s passing in September 2025, Claire has continued to show extraordinary strength. Her dedication to recovery has been nothing short of remarkable, inspiring everyone around her.

Claire’s journey is one of courage, love, and perseverance. We are grateful to have her as part of the Renaissance family, where her strength and spirit continue to inspire us all.




