
NEW HAMPSHIRE CATHOLIC APPEAL UPDATE

Saints We Remember This Week



St. Camillus de Lellis (July 14)

Born in 1550 in Italy, St. Camillus was a soldier who struggled with gambling before a profound conversion. He dedicated his life to caring for the sick and dying, founding the **Order of Clerks Regular, Ministers to the Sick** (the Camillians). He is the patron saint of nurses, hospitals, and the sick.




St. Bonaventure (July 15)

Born in 1221, St. Bonaventure was a Franciscan friar and theologian known as the "Seraphic Doctor." As Minister General, he unified the Franciscan Order and later became a Cardinal and Bishop of Albano. He is a Doctor of the Church and a model of holiness and learning.



Our Lady of Mount Carmel (July 16)

This title of Mary comes from Mount Carmel in Israel, where hermits lived in devotion to her. **Our Lady of Mount Carmel** is the patroness of the **Carmelite Order** and is associated with the Brown Scapular, a sign of her protection. The feast celebrates Mary's guidance and help on our journey to Christ.



St. Apollinaris (Optional Memorial – July 20)

St. Apollinaris was a 1st-century bishop sent by St. Peter to Ravenna. He preached the Gospel courageously, suffered many persecutions, and ultimately gave his life for the faith. He is honored as the **first Bishop of Ravenna** and a steadfast witness to Christ.
