SAINTS WE REMEMBER THIS WEEK

St. Lawrence of Brindisi (July 21) was a gifted Franciscan preacher and theologian who brought many to deeper faith through his eloquence and learning.

St. Mary Magdalene (July 22) is known as the "Apostle to the Apostles." She was the first to see the risen Christ and proclaim the Resurrection.

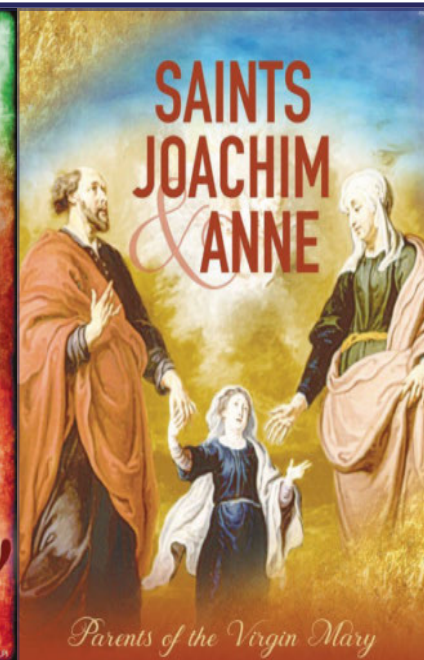
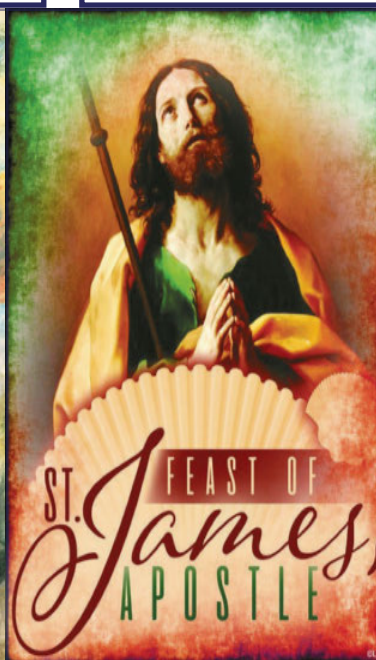
St. Bridget of Sweden (July 23) was a wife, mother, and mystic who founded a religious order and shared powerful visions that guided many toward Christ.

St. Sharbel Makhluf (July 24) was a Maronite monk and hermit from Lebanon known for his deep prayer, humility, and miraculous healings.

St. James, Apostle (July 25) was the brother of John and among Jesus' closest disciples. He was the first Apostle to be martyred for the faith.

Sts. Joachim and Anne (July 26) are honored as the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary and grandparents of Jesus, reminding us of the importance of faith in the family.

May their witness inspire us to live our own vocations with courage and love.

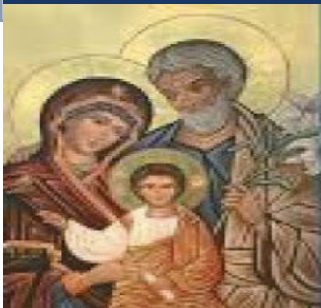

MEN'S GROUP ON MONDAY MORNINGS

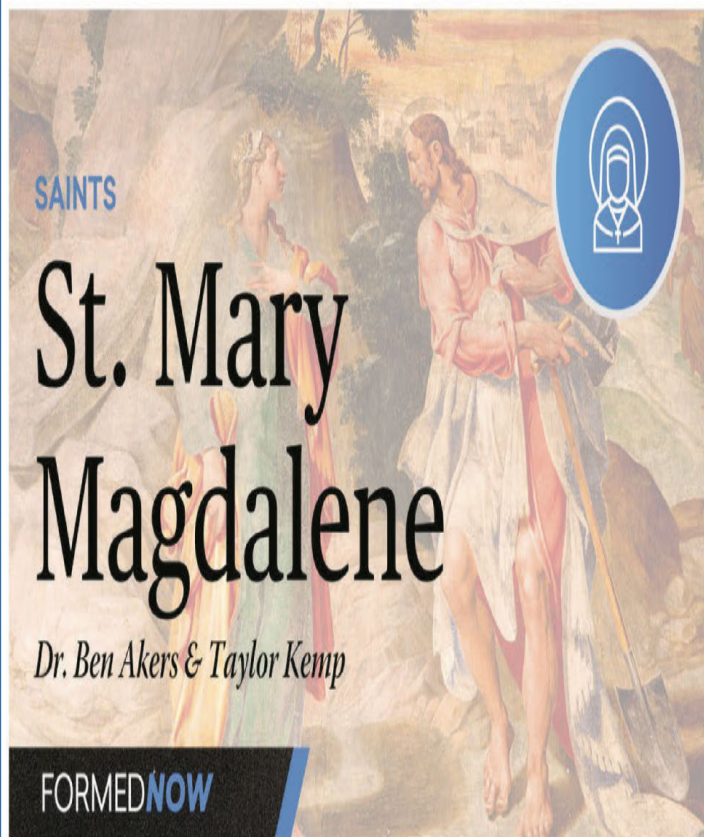
The Men's Group meets from 6:30 - 7:30 AM on Mondays weekly at Pope Francis Hall.
