

SUNDAY, AUGUST 3 – 18TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Readings: Eccl 1:2; 2:21-23 / Ps 90:3-4, 5-6, 12-13, 14, 17 (1) /Col 3:1-5, 9-11 / Lk 12:13-21

Monday, August 4 – St. John Vianney, Priest

Patron saint of parish priests, known for his deep humility, holiness, and tireless hours in the confessional.

Readings: Nm 11:4b-15 / Ps 81:12-13, 14-15, 16-17 / Mt 14:13-21

TUESDAY, AUGUST 5 - DEDICATION OF THE BASILICA OF ST. MARY MAJOR

This is the oldest church in the West dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, built after a miraculous snowfall in Rome.

Readings: Nm 12:1-13 / Ps 51:3-4, 5-6ab, 6cd-7, 12-13 /Mt 14:22-36 or Mt 15:1-2, 10-14

Wednesday, August 6 – The Transfiguration of the Lord

Jesus revealed His divine glory to Peter, James, and John, shining with light and speaking with Moses and Elijah.

Readings: Dn 7:9-10, 13-14 / Ps 97:1-2, 5-6, 9 /2 Pt 1:16-19 / Lk 9:28b-36

THURSDAY, AUGUST 7 – ST. SIXTUS II & COMPANIONS; ST. CAJETAN

St. Sixtus II was a pope and martyr who died during Roman persecution;

St. Cajetan worked to reform the clergy and care for the poor.

Readings: Nm 20:1-13 / Ps 95:1-2, 6-7, 8-9 / Mt 16:13-23

FRIDAY, AUGUST 8 – ST. DOMINIC, PRIEST

Founder of the Dominican Order, St. Dominic promoted the Rosary and preached truth with love and clarity.

Readings: Dt 4:32-40 / Ps 77:12-13, 14-15, 16 and 21 / Mt 16:24-28 **SATURDAY, AUGUST 9 - ST. TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS**

Also known as Edith Stein, a Jewish philosopher who became a Carmelite nun and was martyred at Auschwitz.

Readings: Dt 6:4-13 / Ps 18:2-3a, 3bc-4, 47 and 51 / Mt 17:14-20 **SUNDAY, AUGUST 10 – 19TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

Readings: Wis 18:6-9 / Ps 33:1, 12, 18-19, 20-22 (12b) /Heb 11:1-2, 8-19 or 11:1-2, 8-12 / Lk 12:35-40



WHAT IS THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD? (CELEBRATED AUGUST 6)

One day, Jesus took three of His closest friends—Peter, James, and John—up a tall mountain to pray. While they were there, something amazing happened!

Jesus' clothes became bright white, and His face shone like the sun!

This was called the Transfiguration, because Jesus' appearance changed. It showed the disciples that He was not just a teacher or a prophet—He is truly the Son of God!

Suddenly, Moses and Elijah, two great leaders from the Old Testament, appeared and talked with Jesus. Then, a bright cloud came over them, and they heard God's voice say: "This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him." (Mark 9:7)


