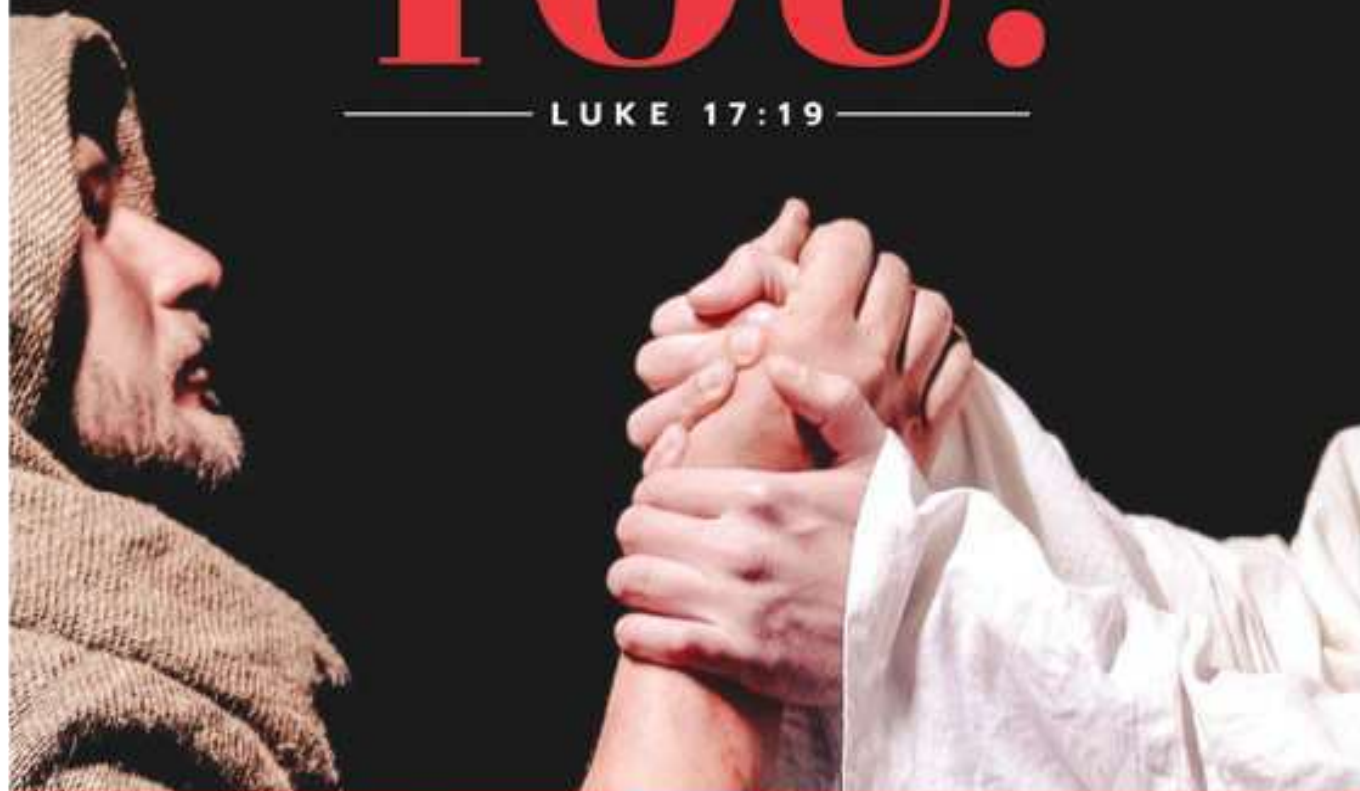

Sunday, October 12 – Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Kings 5:14–17 / Psalm 98:1, 2–3, 3–4 / Second Letter of Saint Paul to Timothy 2:8–13 / Luke 17:11–19

Jesus heals ten lepers, reminding us that gratitude and faith bring true wholeness.

Monday, October 13 – Columbus Day; Indigenous Peoples' Day

Romans 1:1–7 / Psalm 98:1, 2–3ab, 3cd–4 / Luke 11:29–32

A day to reflect on exploration, reconciliation, and honoring the gifts of all peoples.

Tuesday, October 14 – Saint Callistus I, Pope and Martyr

Romans 1:16–25 / Psalm 19:2–3, 4–5 / Luke 11:37–41

A third-century pope who upheld mercy and unity in the face of persecution.

Wednesday, October 15 – Saint Teresa of Jesus, Virgin & Doctor of the Church

Romans 2:1–11 / Psalm 62:2–3, 6–7, 9 / Luke 11:42–46

Carmelite mystic and reformer whose writings lead souls toward deeper union with God.

Thursday, October 16 – Saint Hedwig, Religious; Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, Virgin

Romans 3:21–30 / Psalm 130:1b–2, 3–4, 5–6ab / Gospel of Luke 11:47–54

Saint Hedwig devoted her life to charity; Saint Margaret Mary revealed Christ's Sacred Heart to the world.

Friday, October 17 – Saint Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop and Martyr

Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans 4:1–8 / Psalm 32:1b–2, 5, 11 / Gospel of Luke 12:1–7

Early bishop who gave his life for Christ and called all Christians to unity and courage.

Saturday, October 18 – Saint Luke, Evangelist

Second Timothy 4:10–17b / Psalm 145:10–11, 12–13, 17–18 / Gospel of Luke 10:1–9

Physician and Gospel writer who proclaimed God's mercy with compassion and clarity.

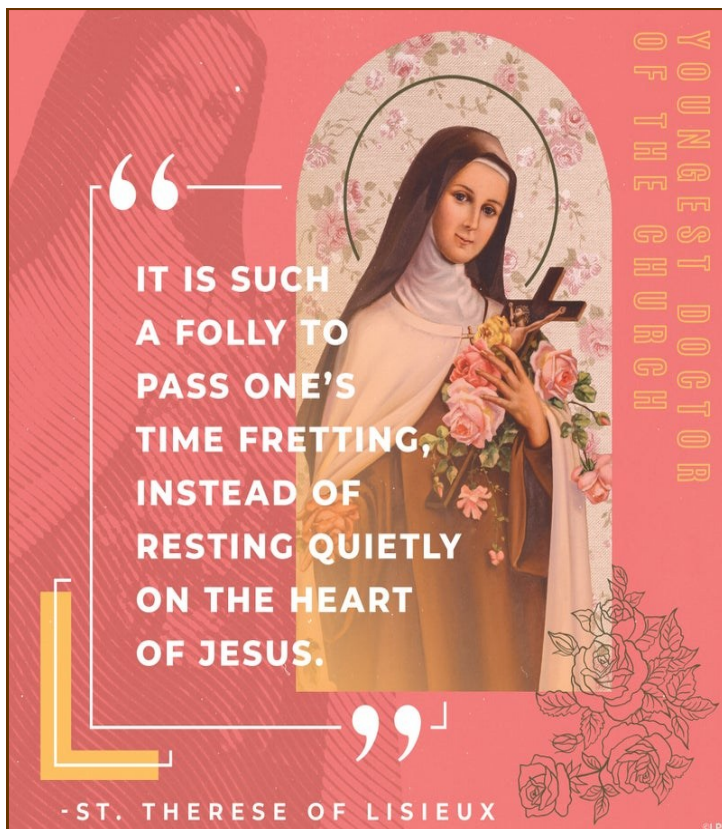
