

#### **ALL SAINTS DAY**

The solemnity of **All Saints** dates back to the early centuries of the Church, when Christians gathered to honor the martyrs who gave their lives for the faith. By the 7th century, Pope Boniface IV dedicated the Pantheon in Rome to Mary and all the martyrs, establishing May 13 as the Feast of All Saints.

Later, in the 9th century, **Pope Gregory IV** extended the celebration to the whole Church and moved it to **November** 1, to honor not only the martyrs but all holy men and women—known and unknown—who now share in the glory of heaven.


All Saints Day reminds us that holiness is not limited to a few; it is the call of every baptized person. We rejoice in the saints' example and ask for their prayers as we strive to live lives of faith, hope, and love.

#### **ALL SOULS' DAY**

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, commonly known as All Souls' Day, is observed on November 2, the day after All Saints. While All Saints celebrates those already in heaven, All Souls is a day of prayer for all who have died and are still being purified on their way to eternal life with God.

The tradition began in the 10th century, when Abbot St. Odilo of Cluny asked all Benedictine monasteries to offer special prayers and Masses for the souls of the departed each year on November 2. The practice soon spread throughout the universal Church.

On this day, we remember our loved ones who have gone before us, and we pray that through the mercy of God, they may rest in peace and share fully in the joy of heaven.




