

# OCIA

### Do You Know as Much as a Catechumen? — Part II

Those preparing for Baptism or full communion through OCIA/OCIC spend months learning about Scripture, the sacraments, how the Church works, Catholic social teaching, prayer, and moral decision-making. In fact, those in formation often learn, and forget, more theology in a few months than many lifelong Catholics ever encounter., which is a reminder that faith is something we keep learning, not something we finish.

#### The Role of the Parish Community

The formation of catechumens and candidates does not belong only to a class or a team, it belongs to the entire parish.

#### The Church Asks the Whole Assembly to Take Part Through: Prayer/Welcome and Hospitality/ Witness of Lived Faith/ Mentorship

#### Rite of Welcome for OCIA/OCIC — What Does It Mean?

Catechumens and candidates will celebrate the Rite of Welcome this Sunday at the 11:30 AM Mass. This rite is the Church's public way of receiving them and promising our prayer and support as they continue their journey of faith.

Catechumens are not yet baptized and are preparing to receive Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

Candidates are already baptized.

- Those baptized in the Catholic Church that are aged 18 and over complete an online diocesan formation and are confirmed at the Cathedral with the Bishop.
- Those baptized in another Christian faith continue their preparation in the parish and will be received into full communion through Confirmation and Eucharist.


