

PASTOR'S DESKTOP

Some parishioners were disappointed that I did not mention Charlie Kirk by name last week. I want to explain why. The Church's liturgical guidelines ask that the homily and announcements avoid partisan politics or the appearance of taking sides. My role as a priest is to proclaim the Gospel and to keep our focus on Jesus Christ, who calls us to unity and peace. If I were to speak about one particular tragedy, such as the murder of Charlie Kirk, I would also need to address other heartbreaking events, like recent school shootings and acts of violence in our communities. This would quickly become overwhelming and could unintentionally cause division or hurt.

This does not mean we are indifferent. As Christians, our response is always prayer and compassion. Today, we pray for the repose of Charlie Kirk's soul, for comfort and strength for his wife and children, and for all those who are grieving. We also lift up all victims of recent tragedies, especially families affected by senseless acts of violence. May Christ bring healing to our nation, and may our parish always be a place of peace and hope.


Congratulations to Abby Clark and Emily Vance!

Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati (April 6, 1901 – July 4, 1925)

Pier Giorgio Frassati was an Italian young man known for his deep faith, love of the poor, and joyful spirit. An avid outdoorsman and skilled mountain climber, he often used his hikes to bring friends closer to God. Despite coming from a wealthy family, he quietly served the sick and needy, especially through the St. Vincent de Paul Society. Pier Giorgio was a university student studying engineering, hoping to use his degree to improve working conditions for miners and laborers. He died of polio at just 24 years old. Pope John Paul II called him the "Man of the Beatitudes," and he is a patron of young adults and students. His feast day is celebrated on July 4th.

The Bristol Knights of Columbus will be collecting donations and non perishable food items every Sunday In September. Donations will be matched up to \$2000.00.






