Private Moments

Five-star exclusivity awaits travelers at the Wymara Resort and Villas in Turks and Caicos.

While Miami has its share of elite waterfront hotels with every amenity imaginable, none of them offer villas with swimming platforms cantilevered over the ocean like Wymara Resort and Villas in Turks and Caicos. Averaging more than 8,000 square feet with at least four bedrooms, each of the six new oceanfront villas sits on approximately a half acre of elevated hillside overlooking the bay at Turtle Tail and each has its own infinity pool, stone-walled courtyard, sunken outdoor fire pit lounge and hardwood deck. Inside are chic interiors finished with Italian porcelain floors and dark wenge wood accents and featuring rain showers and spa tubs that fill from the ceiling, along with floor-to-ceiling windows framing the movie-perfect blues of the Atlantic.

From Miami International Airport,

the estimated time from takeoff to organic body scrub or snorkeling can be less than three hours altogether, as Wymara is only 12 minutes away from Providenciales International Airport (PLS). For those who enjoy equal parts leisure (especially within the confines of the property's spa, with its private shower gardens and fitness center facing the ocean) and adventure (typically in the form of deep-sea diving and fishing) Wymara is a sensible draw.

Now through mid-December guests can enjoy the Live Your Best Villa Life promotion, which includes meals prepared by a private chef and 12-hour access to a villa host who handles everything from arranging island excursions to poolside rum punch cocktail classes.
