Tech Suit Information and Team Store Reminder

Tech suits are a common topic as we head into championship season, so we want to share some guidance to help families make informed decisions.

USA Swimming rules state that swimmers 12 years old and under are not permitted to wear technical (tech) suits at any USA Swimming sanctioned meet. This includes suits with compression or performance-enhancing materials. Swimmers 13 and over may wear tech suits, but they are never required. For older athletes, we encourage families to check with their coach if they are unsure whether a tech suit is appropriate.

If a swimmer is not wearing a tech suit at a meet, they should wear their Brazadas team suit, as it is part of our team uniform and helps promote a unified team presence on deck.

Brazadas Swim Club families can purchase tech suits and team swimwear through our FINIS team store at <https://www.finisswim.com/partners/brazadas>. Tech suits can be found under the Swimwear section. Families receive 30% off using the code `brazadas30`. We also have sample tech suits available in the office if you would like to see them in person before purchasing.

When you shop through our vendor and use the team code, a portion of the purchase goes back to Brazadas Swim Club. This support helps us provide polos for coaches and officials and may help fund future programs such as swim lessons and additional swim equipment. Every purchase through our sponsor helps support Brazadas Swim Club, and we truly appreciate it.
