Ashland family,

A mentor of mine once observed that the measure of an effective offense in football is not how many plays the team runs, but whether or not they actually move the ball down the field. He then asked me, "Is the church you serve moving the ball down the field (i.e., making progress in making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world), or are you just running plays (i.e., doing what you've always done without pausing to assess what you are—or are not—accomplishing for the sake of God's kingdom)?"

Ashland, you are moving the ball down the field! Since our summer small groups, Ashland continues to grow its impact on children and youth beyond just the implementation of children's messages in worship and delivering their colorful pictures to homebound members. One instance of this was on November 9 when we had 16 children in worship between the two services! A special thanks to Ryan Keith and to the many volunteers who work so diligently to disciple our children and youth!

You are moving the ball down the field when it comes to caring for one another. Our congregational care team has now delivered Communion twice and will continue to offer this ministry to our homebound members. Additionally, we had our first grief support group for people who have lost a child or grandchild on November 2. Our next gathering will be on Sunday, December 14 at 3 p.m.

You are moving the ball down the field when it comes to outreach to our local community. Our Communion offering on November 2 and the accompanying match from the Pastor's Discretionary Fund yielded more than \$4500 for Sharing God's Love. Fourteen Learning Buddies have now been mentoring students at Seven Oaks for nearly a month.

The final initiative from the small groups, creating a shepherding system, is now in a position to begin. I have scheduled a meeting with those who expressed an interest in helping with this for December 4th. This initiative is so important! When I arrived at Ashland and began reaching out to people who have become disconnected from Ashland over the years, I discovered that there were several hundred people who have fallen through the cracks in the past. My prayer is that creating an intentional shepherding system will ensure that everyone in the church will feel noticed, cared for, and connected.

In this season of Advent—a season of watching for the presence of Christ and his kingdom—I celebrate the many ways you are already making Christ's presence known through your care, outreach, and investment in making disciples!

- If your address has changed during 2025, ensure that the church has your correct address on file so that your year-end giving statement is mailed to the correct address.
- All expense reimbursements for 2025 should be submitted to the finance office by Wednesday, December 31st. Reimbursement requests related to 2025 that are received after this date may be applied to the 2026 budget instead of the 2025 budget.
