#### Ashland family,

As I have been doing for the past few months, I want to give updates here of the progress being made on the first-year ministry initiatives that grew out of the small groups in July. I won't share anything this time about the children's messages and children's artwork, as those have been up and running for several months now!

**Serving at Seven Oaks Elementary** – Fourteen disciples from Ashland will begin serving as Learning Buddies at Seven Oaks the week of November 3! In total, these disciples will assist around 30-40 students each week! Additionally, Ashland's blood drive on October 19 collected 34 blood donations. Not only could these donations save around 100 lives, but they also qualified Ashland to receive a \$500 grant for Seven Oaks, allowing the school to purchase candy for its Trunk or Treat.

**Communion delivery to homebound members** – The congregational care team did its first Communion delivery on October 5. In the words of one of the disciples who delivered Communion, "What a very special time for my care partner and me celebrating Communion today! She is SO appreciative of this 'new' way to offer her Communion. Thank you for giving me the opportunity to be a part of such a special service."

Creating a support group for those who have lost children or grandchildren – We will have our first group on Sunday, November 2 at 3 p.m. in Room 138. I extend a HUGE thank you to Jane Foster and Kim Gordon for their thoughtful, dedicated work organizing this.

**Creating a Shepherding system** – Now that these other initiatives are making progress, I will soon be reaching out to those who have expressed an interest in planning this initiative.

I also want to share a few other exciting updates. Two grant applications were submitted earlier in October to the Columbia District and SC Conference boards of Congregational Development toward the purchase and installation of a new electronic sign. Additionally, you might have noticed new faces leading music in our worship services. Hao Wu has begun playing piano in the traditional worship service. Musicians Sutton Jenkins, TJ Johnson, and Alena Crowley have shared their musical gifts at the Path in recent weeks.

While Advent is drawing near, all of these signs of hope and new life remind me that we are ultimately an Easter people. Thank you for the roles you each play in this unique expression of the Body of Christ, as we participate in God's life-giving, healing work together!

#### **Snack Packs for Seven Oaks Elementary**

Ashland has provided weekly snack packs for children at Seven Oaks Elementary School since the beginning of the school year. Our volunteers pack non-perishable food and deliver the packs in time for students to take them home for the weekend.

Seven Oaks has identified over 70 children who need the weekend food. Ashland's generosity means that all these children receive a snack pack every Friday. For the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays, we will provide extra items inside snack packs to help feed children when they are not receiving meals at school.

You can help the snack pack mission by contributing to Ashland's snack pack mission fund or by purchasing food items to place in the snack pack bin near room 102. Our most needed food items are 15 oz cans of pasta (spaghetti, ravioli) and juice boxes.
