- ◆ Home team scorer must enter game into GameChanger by 9pm Sunday
- ◆ Umpires details must be entered into Notes section of GameChanger before the game commences.
- ◆ Any incidents or accidents during the game must be recorded in the Notes section of GameChanger
 - ◆ Officials and Players in the dugouts ONLY!
- ◆ Umpires and Scorers, whether accredited or not, are entitled to respect and dignity and shall have the full protection by the GCBA President.
- ◆ Any issues with rules or regulations can be directed to the host club Duty Officer

The only communication between coaches and green & yellow shirt umpires is to be positional changes.

If an umpire boots a call, suck it up!

Rules for 2020/21



JUNIOR LEAGUE

Game Day:	Saturday
Game Time:	10:15am
Venues:	Mudgeeraba, Surfers Paradise, Runaway Bay, Coomera, Robina.
Scorers:	This league will be scored using the GameChanger Application, the Home Team is responsible for entering the Game into GameChanger.
Umpires:	The Home Team is responsible for supplying the Plate Umpire, the Away Team is responsible for supplying the Base Umpire
Field Size:	80ft Bases 54ft Pitching Distance
Game:	7 Innings or 2 Hours whichever is arrived at first. No new inning may be commenced with less than ten minutes of scheduled time remaining
Ball Type:	Standard 9' RBI Baseball
Bat Type:	Any bat with a maximum barrel diameter of 2 1/4 Inches. Or any 2 5/8 Barrel Bat with the USA Bat Label.
Level of Play:	This is the highest level of play for this Age Group within the GCBA
Goals:	The GCBA aims for the players to play the highest quality competition on a weekly basis.
Non Forfeit:	All teams agree to undertake whatever lengths necessary to ensure every scheduled game is played.

Mandatory: One (1) at bat plus six (6) defensive outs

Pitch Count: **Pre Christmas**
Maximum of 50 Pitches per day

Post Christmas
Maximum of 85 Pitches per day

Pitchers, once removed from the mound CAN NOT return as pitchers.

Pitcher/Catcher: A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day. A player who has played the position of catcher in four or more innings in a game is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day

Substitutions: Defensive: Must be made as team takes the field, or while team is in the field.
Offensive: Must be made as player comes to bat, or while player is on base.
Scorers must only be made aware of the following changes:
*When a Pitcher is Replaced, When a Catcher is replaced, When a Hitter is replaced.
*Defensive changes outside of the battery, and pinch runners do not need to be recorded.

Run Rules: **Pre Christmas**
Maximum of (4) runs per inning

Post Christmas
Maximum of (6) runs per inning

**In the event of an over the fence/cone home run
all runs will be recorded.**

Coaches: Must hold a Level 3 Accreditation, Must be in Team Polo, Shorts and enclosed shoes. Must wear a skull cap while base coaching
