Pitchers, once removed from the mound CAN NOT return as pitchers.

Pitcher/Catcher: A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game

cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day. A player who has played the position of catcher in four or more innings in a game is not eligible to pitch

on that calendar day

Substitutions: Defensive: Must be made as team takes the field, or

while team is in the field.

Offensive: Must be made as player comes to bat, or while

player is on base.

Scorers must only be made aware of the following changes:

*When a Pitcher is Replaced, When a Catcher is

replaced, When a Hitter is replaced.

*Defensive changes outside of the battery, and pinch

runners do not need to be recorded.

Run Rules: Pre Christmas
