TEE BALL

Game Day: Saturday

Game Time: TBA

Venues: TBA

Field Size: 40ft Bases

Game: 9 Innings or 1 Hour whichever is arrived at first.
No new inning may be commenced with less than ten minutes of scheduled time remaining

Players: 6 a side Tee Ball. Players occupy all Infield positions and two (2) outfielders.
Players must alternate positions every inning.
Team Coach to play First Base for their team on fielding innings.

of Swings: Players will receive up to three (3) attempts to put the ball in play.
On the 3rd attempt if they miss or hit the ball foul they are encouraged to still run to first base while the fielding team attempts to make the play.

Ball Type: X Plate 9' RBI Baseball

Bat Type: Any bat with a maximum barrel diameter of 2 1/4 Inches

Level of Play: This is a designated developmental league for very young players or those new to the game.
All teams will play a minimum 5 Players per team.

Goals: The GCBA aims for the players to enjoy an even level of baseball.
The emphasis is on development of all players.

Non Forfeit: All teams agree to undertake whatever lengths necessary to ensure every scheduled game is played.

Mandatory: All players must play a different position every inning.

Coaches: Must hold a Level 1 Accreditation, Must be in Team Polo, Shorts and enclosed shoes.
Coaches must also stand as the First Baseman for all fielding innings for their team.
