



Georgia Primary Election Results

Georgia voters headed to the polls yesterday for the 2026 primary elections, setting the stage for several high-profile runoff contests and November matchups. In the race for U.S. Senate, Republicans Mike Collins and Derek Dooley advanced to a runoff and will compete for the chance to challenge incumbent Senator Jon Ossoff in the general election.

At the top of the statewide ticket, the governor's race is also headed to a Republican runoff between Rick Jackson and Burt Jones, while former Atlanta Mayor Keisha Lance Bottoms secured the Democratic nomination outright with 56% of the vote. Several other statewide offices will see competitive runoffs, including lieutenant governor, secretary of state, and insurance commissioner on the Democratic side. Notably, Brian Strickland and Tanya Miller clinched their respective party nominations for attorney general without a runoff.

In judicial races, incumbents largely held their seats, with close margins in the Georgia Supreme Court contest between Charlie Bethel and Miracle Rankin. Down-ballot races for Congress and the state legislature produced a mix of decisive primaries and crowded runoffs, signaling continued competition within both parties across the state.

Georgia's primary runoff elections will take place on June 16, 2026, while the general election is scheduled for November 3, 2026. These upcoming contests will determine the final candidates who will appear on the ballot this fall in what is expected to be a closely watched election cycle statewide.
