

Georgia Life Sciences is seeking a Georgia educator to complete an internship this summer to help develop a new MedTech teacher workshop, which will become part of the Biotech Teacher Training Initiative (BTTI) portfolio.

Time commitment: 20-25 hours over summer, ~20 hours in fall

This is a hybrid internship. The majority will be virtual, but some in-state travel is expected; business mileage and relevant expenses will be reimbursed.

Rate: \$25/hr

The teacher intern will:

- Attend and gather data from a MedTech industry roundtable (virtual)
- Potentially meet with several companies (virtual or in-person)
- Tweak existing curriculum to meet the needs of Georgia's industry
- Develop an "Essential Skills" list for MedTech entry level jobs
- Create job profiles for 2-3 jobs in Medtech (short articles for students and/or video interviews)
- Create materials list for a fall workshop
- Facilitate pilot workshop in fall (in-person, date TBD- 1.5 day, Friday+Saturday in Sep/Oct)
- Assess effectiveness of pilot workshop and tweak curriculum as needed.

Qualifications

Required

- Current middle or high school science or CTAE teacher
- Employed in a public school in Georgia

Preferred

- Alumni of BTTI/RTTI workshops
- Experience with engineering and/or medical device development
