Lamy House

The Lamy's were grandparents raising six or seven of their orphaned grand children when we arrived in Haiti. The foundation of a new house had been started but funds never were available for completion. HMI placed completion of their house as top priority once the water well drill was in place and functioning. The Lamy's and their family of grand children have thrived since moving from a one room dilapidated hut to a four room block building providing protection and space for everyone.
