We have surpassed our Sponsor goal of \$150,000 in donations and pledges for the 2023 Silent Auction. We have received Gold and Builder Sponsors which have brought our current total to \$175,300. Mesi anpil (thank you very much!) and Bondye beni (may God bless) all of our generous sponsors! It is clear from the donor phase that God's plan is that we should continue to build a minimum of four homes per month. Each home cost \$8000 with \$4000 contributed from money raised from the SA. We are close to our goal of \$192,000 for the Silent Auction which will provide matching funds for the next 48 homes. 

Not that misery is not a routine part of life for a majority of Haitians but when words like inflation and economic downturns begin appearing in daily newsfeeds, you can be sure that means bad news - really bad news -for any country listed as "third world" but particularly Haiti. Overnight it seemed that desperation set in. No fuel, no food, no supplies of any kind. The good news (if any could be found) was that the Haitians have come to expect these types of situations. They certainly tried their best to call for help but most just hunkered down, tried to stay safe and prayed. Haiti Mission did the same.

Thanks be to God the system we have in place to transfer funds directly to Fr. Joe via legitimate banks allowed us to transfer funds once things settled down and supplies and fuel became available. Although we hoped and prayed that the situation would improve after the first of the year - in August 2022 it was just that - HOPE! Then, as the new year began, it was clear that our prayers were answered. Things began loosening up, our construction team got cranked up, kids were able to go back to school and cautious hope was restored. You'll read in the newsletter how our construction team is rapidly catching up on our backlog of houses (What a blessing to have!) by building five houses a month. Amazing! We're back in business so to speak. Planning is going forward full steam ahead for our annual silent auction and golf tournament and plans for two mission trips this Summer and two in the Fall are well underway. What can we say other than thank God for answered prayers. All of this ultimately boils down to the famous Benedictine motto of "Work like everything depends on you. Pray like everything depends on God!" And then of course, the famous Christopher motto, "It's better to light one candle than to curse the darkness!" (Haiti mission kind of adapted that to say "it's better to distribute one solar light, than to curse the darkness!!") Thanks again for hanging in there with us!


