Chintakunta village was selected because of the pronounced number of restrictions due to the different castes in that village. The low caste people do manual labor, working for the land owners from morning till evening and are paid minimal wages. These people have been struggling with drinking water problems for many years, having to travel considerable distances to get some water to drink and use for any other purpose. Based upon the caste structure of this village and their need. The Coronavirus has been very prevalent in this area, creating additional challenges. Now the problem is inflation which these people are also facing. As you know everything went up in such a way that the common man is unable to live with this kind of inflation. It is affecting every sector of work and life.
