## Indian Well - Well #8 - Koilkuntla

Location of the Project: <u>Koilkuntla</u> – Ankireddy Colony. Kurnool District. Andhrapradesh. State.

## **Details of the Project:**

Ankireddy Colony in Koilkuntla is a large community. All the daily wage workers from different villages have come to settle here to try to make a living doing various types of manual labor. All of them are poor, many with large families. Their daily schedule begins very early in the morning and finished after 5: 00 p.m. Farming is still the primary work in these areas.

NEED OF THE PROJECT: At present the community has drinking water from a nearby river which is about a mile distance. River water is available when there are good rains. if the rains don't come naturally (as often happens) the flow of the water in the river dries up. Many summers it is hardly possible to get a pot of water. The people have to resort to digging holes in the sand at the river beds in order to get a little water for drinking and other purposes. (I am very familiar with this situation because I grew up in this kind of situation as a child and even the first years of my priesthood.) I can assure you that this will be a great blessing and humanitarian service for the people of Koilkuntla.
