

Uganda - Well #2 St. Boniface Church Bughanga, Uganda In Memory of Casey Petri



The Rehabilitation of the Bughanga well Project in Memory of Casey Petri.

The engineer handed over the well to the community in the presence of the Pastor, Rev. Thomas Aquinas Outa on the 8th of January 2018. There was a lot of excitement and jubilation from the community upon seeing the clean water flowing from the borehole. On the same day, the community held a meeting in which the village chief and his committee members finalized a maintenance plan for the well. The community assured Haiti Mission, Inc that they will cooperate and do all that is possible to maintain the borehole now that it has been re-drilled and repaired. All the families in the community including Muslims have

registered and have begun contributing 500 Ugandana Shillings (fifty cents US) a month that will be used in the maintenance of the borehole. They had already raised 20,000 Ug Shs (\$10) by the time of the dedication of the well. The small fee that they have begun contributing will be kept with their treasurer and be used for maintenance and repair of the well. The Bughangha community sends their heartfelt thanks and appreciation for this wonderful gift of potable water for all the children and families that have been suffering so much because of the drought that has plagued the region.
