## Nan Sannite Well

Nan Sannite is a small cluster of families that are settled between the valley of Numero Deux and the community of Pawotee which lies at the top of the mountain rising from the Caribbean coast. The families here had no readily available water supply. The job of fetching water — primarily by the children — required at least a half mile trek to the top or bottom of the mountain. This well now brings potable water to these families and to all the school children moving up and down the mountain to go to school, church and market. This excellent and pristine water source now reduces the need to go for water and carrying it long distances in the sun (which can allow bacteria to grow and contamination of all types to occur). This will also give the children more time to play and study rather than having to spend so much time getting water for the family.
