

Haiti Well #53 - Fon Rouge B

Fond Rouge is a community on the mountain above the Haitian Health Foundation hospital in Jeremie. The people there were having to walk about two miles up and down the mountain to the nearest water source, using donkeys to carry the heavy jugs of water. The HMI team drilled one well there the first week of April 2017. Since there were so many people that lived in this community and since it was so difficult to get our rig up the mountain to this location, we decided to drill a second well (B) while our equipment was there. This way, when one well would go down for repair, the other well should still be functioning. This well was drilled in memory of Phyllis Winkley in the hopes that her memory and her beautiful life will bring living water to this community for many years to come.
