## Uganda - Well #6 Aoja

Aoja Village is in Uganda, East Africa. It is served by St. Michael's Catholic Church which is part of the Diocese of Soroti. Aoja is a remote village at the far side of the sub county of Asamuk. Since the place is so remote, the people there have always lacked the basic social services such as education, health care and readily available potable water. Thanks to a donation received in 2016, an elementary school was built on community property furnished by St. Michael's church. Before that the children had to walk several miles to attend the nearest school.

This fresh water well borehole project will be drilled near by the school thus serving the school (which has approx. 400 students) and the community around the school which consists of about seventy families.

The people of Aoja Village Uganda wish to extend their heartfelt gratitude to One Family International and Haiti Mission for initiating this project which will be an incredible blessing to everyone living in the region.


