I am glad to inform you that the repair of the Mulagi well has today on June 8th 2018 successfully been completed. The main beneficiaries of this well are the pupils of St. Kizito Primary School, the students of St. Boniface technical School and St. Mary's Girl's Secondary School during their school time and the parish community of Mulagi Catholic Church. The entire Mulagi community is extremely grateful for this very wonderful gift that you have given to us and they promise to maintain the well so that it can serve them longer.

The new recommended stainless steel pipes and rods were successfully installed. The water was also treated and is now very clean. The plaque has been fixed on the borehole with a permanent inscription of the words:

In Memory of Ignance and Bertha Charles. "Where there is love, there is life."

(Gandi)

The color of the plague is moreorless golden and it reflects light. However, I was not sure of the spelling of the name *Ghandi or Gandhi*. However, the artist forgot an "h" and ended up writing "Gandi". But any way, he did a wonderful job. The words on the plague are very clear and are visibly seen even from a distance.

I have taken many photographs but I have decided to attach a few significant ones that were taken during the rehabilitation of the well. The Mulagi community has asked me to express their most humble and sincere gratitude to you for this very wonderful gift of water that you have given to them. They promise to pray for you and all the donors for this project, for your intentions and for your good health.
