- 1. You participate in a federal or Minnesota needs-based public assistance program (proof required).

 - Special Supplemental Nutrition Program (WIC)
 - Social Security Disability (SSDI)

 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
 - VA Disability
- 2. You earned less than \$45,000 as an individual or less than \$65,000 as a family in the past year (copy of most recent income tax return required, W-2 forms will not be accepted).

Cost for Program:

Dog Neuter – \$120.00 (rabies included) / \$25 additional if over 80 lbs

Cat Neuter – \$65.00 (rabies included)

Cat Spay – \$80.00 (rabies included)

Dog Spay – \$150.00 (rabies included)/\$25 additional if over 80 lbs

FVRCCP – \$15.00 (cat) – Boosters done at your own vet

DHLPPC - \$15.00 (dog) — Boosters done at your own vet

Deworming - \$10.00 (cats only)

Microchip - \$35 plus tax (includes registration)

Call to schedule an appointment. The service will be prepaid prior to getting on the surgery schedule. The appointments will mostly be on Mondays and Thursdays, and it will be the same day pick up.

Your animal needs to be in a crate, if you have a giant breed dog and no crate, please ask staff to see if we can assist, there can be an extra charge for kenneling at the shelter.
