

When writing your Saint Report...

★ Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you to a Saint that you can RELATE to! Below are some ideas to help you get started:

-What are you interested in? (Sports, music, animals, science, etc.) — There's probably a patron saint for that!

-Is there a saint whose story you find inspiring? Maybe someone known for their courage, perseverance, kindness, or faith?

Would you like a saint who was young, like you? Many saints were teenagers or young adults when they made a big difference.

-Do you feel connected to a particular country or culture? You might consider a saint from your heritage or nationality.

-Is there a virtue or quality you want to grow in? (Like patience, bravery, humility, leadership, etc.) — Look for a saint known for that trait.

★ Ask that Saint to pray for you in specific ways!

★ Type your double-spaced, one page report on 8.5x11" paper and include:

- ✓ 4-6 of details of the life of this Saint.

- ✓ Make sure you explain HOW YOU connect with and relate to this Saint.

- ✓ Explain why you chose this Saint.

- ✓ Use complete sentences and have a parent or sponsor proof read it.

- As readers read your Saint report, they will learn about that Saint and learn about YOU too!

★ Turn in your Saint Report & Poster in class on **March 11, 2026**.

When creating your Saint Poster...

★ Be creative-the poster is your way of showing others about your Saint.

★ The poster should be no larger than 11x14. This is legal size paper.

You may cut pasteboard to this approximate size.

★ Include pictures of the saint-your own drawing or printed pics.

★ **The poster should include:**

✓ Saint's name

✓ Your name & catechist on the back

✓ What they are the patron saint of

✓ 4-5 interesting facts about their life

★ You can also include a prayer to the Saint!

★ **Turn in your Saint Report & Poster in class on March 11, 2026.**

★ Posters will be displayed at Confirmation.

★ Whichever saint you choose to use for your confirmation

name-that's who your report and poster should be about!
