Funding is available for initiatives that increase participation and help introduce new players to squash and racketball (squash57) in the following areas :

Squash 101
Squash Girls Can
Squash 57
Junior 101

Staffordshire Squash – Criteria for funding

- To support clubs that currently do not have any junior coaching. Clubs to be identified by the Staffordshire Committee.
- To fund or part fund coaches in clubs where there is a shortfall for coaching juniors or implementing the junior 101 program.
- Individual/s to be funded or part funded must be a member of a Staffordshire Squash club that is affiliated to England Squash.
- To part fund or fund clubs that require equipment for junior sessions.
- To part fund clubs that have a current junior program that need more level 1 coaches to help with the number of children.
- Staffordshire Squash will also fund or part fund Staffordshire Squash county run events. Committee will select venues and coaches for the event. Prior to any county run event taking place, the fees for the coaching team and venue to be agreed by the Staffordshire Squash committee.

Notes for clubs applying for funding

- Clubs need to record their participants using the England Squash App which can be found at www.101.englandsquash.com
- To be eligible clubs need to be affiliated to England Squash and show they are actively supporting Staffordshire Squash events and initiatives
- Payment will be made after the project has taken place
- Feedback, lessons learned and App entry figures from initiatives should be shared
