What is Probate?

In each County of Ohio, Probate Court has jurisdiction (authority) to settle estates.

After the *original* Last Will of a deceased person is filed in the appropriate Probate Court, that Court will appoint an Executor to notify all next of kin and all who were named in the Will, to Inventory all Estate assets – (including real estate, financial assets / accounts, & motor vehicles) to deposit funds of the deceased into an Estate account, to pay bills of the estate and then, to prepare the necessary documents to transfer ownership of real estate (such as home &/or land), and to distribute the remaining funds, in accord with Ohio law and the Last Will.
