Trauma rules discussed – the rules have been extended to June 2024. There will be a public comment period in July – Aug 2023. There will be education done for the rules prior to the public comment. There will be increased costs with the new rules. Become familiar with the rules. If you have concerns have your facility provide a letter of concerns.</p> <p>3. Uncompensated care – presentation discussed with the amount of 457\$ million provided in uncompensated care by 291 hospitals. For the year 2023 there is only 113\$ million allotted for 306 hospitals.
