Terms and Conditions

1. ELIGIBILITY

The "Friends on Show" Exhibition is open to financial Friends of Hazelhurst members only. For more details on how to join Friends of Hazelhurst you can visit our website www.friendsofhazelhurst.org or call 8536 5700.

2. MEDIUM

Entries can be original painting, drawing, print, digital print, photograph or mixed media in any medium or 3D works including sculpture, ceramic or mosaic. JEWELLERY AND CARDS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. The theme of the exhibition is open.

3. ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

2D and 3D Works should be of exhibition standard, CLEARLY LABELLED ON BACK OF ARTWORK with Artist Name/Title/Medium/Price (incl. 30% commission). It is possible to get a template of a label from our website or the Administration desk at Hazelhurst. 2D works need to be mounted, framed and ready for hanging with D-rings only. PLEASE REMOVE ANY EXISTING STRING OR WIRE. Stretched canvas will be accepted unframed. Wet paintings will not be accepted.

4. SIZE

2D works must not exceed 100cm wide and 100cm high including framing. Only one artwork per artist will be displayed but if the artwork is a triptych or part of a collection, please indicate on your entry form. If it needs to be hung together, it still must fit within the dimensions indicated. 3D works must fit on a 50 x 50 x 50cm plinth. Note that we are unable to offer both options to artists.

5. HOW TO ENTER

We prefer all entries be completed via the Online Application Form available on our website, www.friendsofhazelhurst.org with payment of a non-refundable entry fee of \$30 per artist. Paper applications will be made available from the Hazelhurst Art Centre reception desk.

Artists may provide a digital image of their artworks. WE WILL ACCEPT A MAXIMUM OF 3 ARTWORKS PER ARTIST ONLY. The artworks must be the artist's own property and be completed in the last two years. No late entries will be accepted.

6. FRIENDS ON SHOW EXHIBITION

The exhibition will be held in the Broadhurst Gallery, at Hazelhurst Arts Centre, 782 Kingsway, Gymea. **Notice of entry and exhibition dates will be available in 2024.**

7. PROCESS OF SELECTION FOR EXHIBITION

The Hazelhurst curators will select the works to be included in the show. Their decision is final, and no correspondence or dispute will be entered into Friends of Hazelhurst. Only selected works will be displayed; however, we will endeavour to represent all artists in the show.

8. DELIVERY OF ENTRIES FOR EXHIBITION

Artworks that artists have entered in the online form for the exhibition must be delivered to Hazelhurst Arts Centre 782 Kingsway, Gymea NSW 2227. Please make sure each artwork delivered is labelled and complies with the specifications. Unselected works must be picked up **by 5pm** on the same day. There is no storage available at Hazelhurst.

9. REPRODUCTION OF IMAGES

Note that artists and their artworks may be photographed for publication purposes promoting the Friends on Show. Friends of Hazelhurst will make appropriate acknowledgement.

10. SALE OF ARTWORK

All entries must be for sale during the exhibition as this is a fundraising event for Friends of Hazelhurst. A commission of 30% applies to all artworks sold with proceeds returned to Friends of Hazelhurst. *Unsold works must be collected by the artists* at the end of the exhibition.

11. INSURANCE

Artists are responsible for insuring their artworks against theft and damage. Reasonable care will be taken but no responsibility for loss, damage or theft will be accepted by Friends of Hazelhurst or Hazelhurst Arts Centre.
