

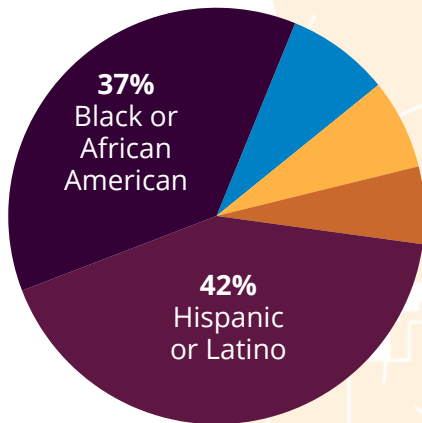

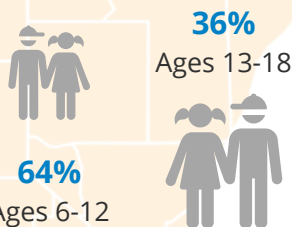

OUR MISSION

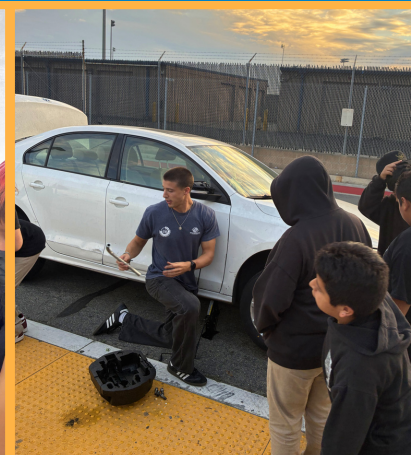
To enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens.

THE CLUB EXPERIENCE

Boys & Girls Clubs of Long Beach provides safe, enriching after-school and summer programs that help youth succeed academically, socially, and emotionally. Serving ages 6–18 across 14 Long Beach locations, including Clubhouses, school sites, and a dedicated LBCC campus Clubhouse, BGCLB offers academic support, college and career readiness, workforce development, wellness services, substance use prevention, and basic needs support such as meals, snacks, and laundry access. Our programs are centered in Long Beach's most under-resourced neighborhoods, ensuring every young person has access to opportunity, support, and a place to belong.

Great Futures Start Here.

Our Life Skills programming gives youth hands-on experiences that are often missing from today's classrooms. Club members are learning practical, real-world skills like cooking healthy meals, sewing, budgeting, changing a tire, and building projects together, including constructing a football goal post for their flag football league. These engaging programs help youth build confidence, independence, teamwork, and problem-solving skills while preparing them for everyday life beyond school.
