


JANUARY, BLACKSHEAR LEARNING CENTER IN HOUSTON

Students participated in yoga as a social-emotional learning enrichment activity.




MAY, DREAM ACADEMY HOUSTON

In our photography and film class at the Village of the Arts Summer Camp, our students got to open their brand new cameras and learn about the practice of visual storytelling through photos and videos.




AUGUST, DREAM ACADEMY HOUSTON


