

Student Code of Conduct Agreement

While engaging in the activities organized and run by the St. Philip Religious Education Program, children are expected to behave appropriately at all times, respecting themselves and others.

General Rules and Expectations

- Keep your hands to yourself
- Use kind words and actions
- Respect your elders (parent volunteers, catechists, director and priests)
- Respect your fellow students
- Respect parish property and facility
- Abide by the Electronic Devices Policy
- Eating is not allowed in the classrooms, except for events allowed by the catechist
- Wear appropriate clothing for a class-setting. NOT allowed: lounge/pajama pants and tops, slippers
- Bring the necessary supplies required for your lesson (texts, pens, Catholic Bible)
- Keep up with the assigned work given by the catechists

Consequences for Infractions: Minor infractions will be dealt with in class with the catechist. Infractions are reported via email to the director and, when a pattern of misconduct becomes evident, the student might have a visit with the director and a note sent home to the parent. Additional misconduct could result in a parent/director meeting being scheduled so that a solution can be jointly agreed upon. At the discretion of the director, a serious or repeated infraction may result in the loss of the privilege of attending in-person classes for which the student will be placed in the home-based program.
