REMINDER: CUTTING OF VERGES



Following on from the communication sent out 23 March, we would like to please remind residents that the HOA has identified several areas where **vegetation (trees, hedges, and plants) is obstructing important road safety and security infrastructure, including street signage, lighting, security cameras, and perimeter electric fencing. In some cases, vegetation is also encroaching into roadways, creating visibility issues and restricting safe vehicle movement.**

We have further received concerns from Pikitup Johannesburg, noting that overhanging vegetation is causing damage to refuse trucks and forcing vehicles to move into oncoming traffic to pass safely. Residents are reminded that vegetation within their property boundaries must be maintained and not interfere with infrastructure or roadways.

Kindly attend to any affected vegetation before 13 April 2026. Thereafter, the HOA will proceed with the necessary trimming where required. Please note that this initiative will also include common areas managed by the HOA. Work is scheduled to commence from 13 April 2026.

As the HOA continuously strive to improve our offering – we have implemented a **new service** to assist with regards to any concerns or complaints that you may have on the estate.

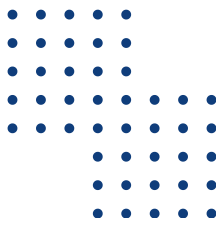
Step 1: WhatsApp San Naidoo on 072 377 5655; with your name, stand number and complaint (please include photos where necessary).

Step 2: The resident will receive an affirmative response that the complaint has been received and shared with the relevant department head or team member via email

Step 3: A response from the relevant department head or team member will be communicated back to the resident within 24 hours.

Please note, there may be some delays for messages received after hours and on weekends.

SPOTLIGHT ON: FISHING ON THE ESTATE



Fishing is allowed on a catch and release basis. Please note fishing is only open to residents. Any visitors must be accompanied by a resident at all times.

Dam 6 – At any time. Hours can extend beyond 19h00.

Dam 2 when the Golf flags are down/removed. Hours can extend beyond 19h00.

Dams 1,3,4,5 & 7 when Golf flags are down/removed until 19h00.

Please note: Fishing may be restricted should any contamination of water be detected during routine inspections, etc. Should there be restrictions for safety or other reasons, these will be communicated and signage will be placed at the dams cautioning the same.

The erection of gazebos are permitted but may not cause damage to common areas. No tents are permitted.

Please ensure all litter and fishing paraphernalia is removed. We have had numerous reports of birds becoming entangled in fishing lines and being injured, as well as hooks being left behind.

No loud noise is permitted at any time.

Dam 13 is a catchment/breeding dam. No fishing permitted at any time.



FREQUENTLY ASKED:

What are the estate rules for when the flags are down on the golf course – can I practise my putting on the greens?

Once the flags are down/removed, the fairways and pathways of the golf course are open to residents to walk, exercise or even have a quiet picnic. However, according to our Estate Rules and Regulations, there are limitations to this usage. **The following areas are always out of bounds: the putting greens, tee boxes and bunkers.** When the flags are down, the golf course is closed to casual golf play and practice. Cycling is only allowed on the pathways and golf cart paths. Dogs are to be walked on leash at all times, and dog walkers/residents must please remove any excrement deposited by their pets.

Importantly, no activity that may cause damage to the golf course will be tolerated, this includes littering, tampering with, or vandalism of, any signage, structures or other equipment and the use of golf carts in such a way as to cause damage to the golf course.
