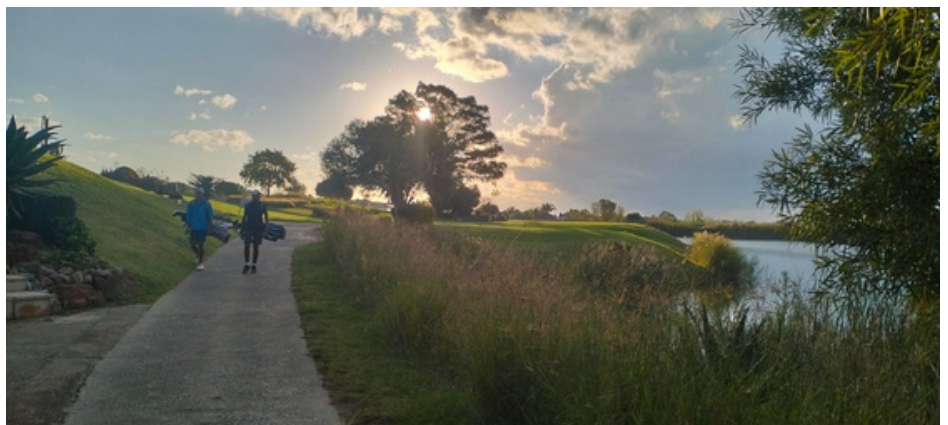

# SPOT LIGHT ON: HOME-RUN BUSINESSES ON THE ESTATE



## REMINDER:

According to our Estate Rules (2014), businesses may not be operated from homes unless the required approval process has been followed and written consent has been obtained where applicable.

Current Relevant Rule (Extract for Reference):

### 11. BUSINESS ACTIVITY

Any member of the HOA, or resident, wishing to conduct any business on his or her property must apply in writing on the prescribed form to the HOA to conduct such business.

The HOA will consider the application on merit, after taking into consideration the following:

- 11.1 The compliance with Municipal by-laws
  - 11.2 Increased traffic
  - 11.3 Parking - employees and customers
  - 11.4 Signage
  - 11.5 Disturbance to other residents and the community as a whole
  - 11.6 Number of employees etc.
  - 11.7 Hours of business
- The decision of the HOA is totally discretionary and will be final and binding.

### Please note:

Operating a business from home without approval may constitute a breach of the Estate Rules and may result in enforcement action.

Members wishing to operate a home-based business should first submit an application and obtain approval before commencing any activity.

Members should note that approval is likely to be unsuccessful where the proposed business is the same as, or similar to, a business already operating commercially within the clubhouse.

For those looking for commercial premises, vacant office space may be available at the clubhouse. If interested, please contact Cliff Howes at the clubhouse for further information.

These rules help maintain the standards of our estate, preserve its residential and aesthetic character, support security, manage traffic flow, and protect the interests of all residents.

## RECYCLING @ EAGLE CANYON



Thursday is recycling day at Eagle Canyon. The service will collect most recyclable material, including electronics.

### HOW TO RECYCLE with Whole Earth Recycling:

**STEP 1:** Residents to use blue refuse bags for their recyclables, alternatively, clear, green, purple, red, or yellow can be utilised (please do not use black bags)

**STEP 2:** Place all of your dry recyclables (paper, plastic, glass, cans, cartons like long-life milk and electronic waste – anything with a plug) together into the same bag (there is no need to sort the recycling into different bags).

**STEP 3:** Place your full bag(s) outside for collection every Thursday morning by 07h30, except on public holidays. Cardboard is to be flattened and placed alongside if it is too bulky to fit into your blue bag(s).

**STEP 4:** Should you have large electronic items for recycling, please contact Whole Earth recycling on 011 791 4537 or email [carmen@wholeearth.co.za](mailto:carmen@wholeearth.co.za) to arrange.

Whole Earth Recycling collects your recycling and takes it to their warehouse where they support a community project consisting of 35 sorters, who sort and sell the recyclables in order to generate an income for themselves.

The following items **CAN** be placed into your blue bags for recycling

#### •Paper

- Cardboard boxes, cardboard sleeves around food packaging, toilet roll tubes and egg boxes.
- Newspapers, magazines, telephone books and flyers.
- White office paper (printed or blank) and colourful paper.

#### •Cartons

- Cartons such as Tetra Pak e.g. long life milk cartons and juice cartons.

#### •Plastic

- Plastic bottles and plastic bottle caps i.e. water or cold drink plastic bottles, plastic milk bottles as well as bottles used for shampoo and cleaning agents.
- Margarine, butter and ice cream tubs.
- Soft plastic bags such as shopping bags, frozen vegetable bags, milk bags and soft bread bags.
- Mat chocolate and other similar plastic containers.
- Polystyrene trays (if it is clean and dry) and polystyrene used to package appliances etc.
- Thick yogurt containers and feta cheese containers that have a triangle with the number 5 inside it.

#### •Glass

- Glass bottles and glass jars (including the metal lids).

#### •Cans

- Food and beverage cans (both steel and aluminium) as well as aerosols.
- Tin foil and foil trays

#### •E-waste

- Computers, printers, CPU's, washing machines, dishwashers, fridges, freezers, telephones and telephone wires.

Please ensure that all recyclables do not have residual food waste or liquids in them.

The following items **CAN'T** be placed into your blue bags for recycling

#### •Food or Garden Waste

- This is organic waste and can be placed in a compost heap, worm farm or a Bokashi bin in order to make compost for your garden.

#### •Multi-layers

- Dog food bags, cat food bags or washing powder bags (these are a combination of plastic and foil that cannot be separated for recycling).

#### •Textiles

- Clothing and other textile items

#### •PET Food Packaging

- Unless they have a number 5 symbol on them
- Transparent muffin trays, transparent salad trays and ready-made sandwich containers.

#### •Batteries or Lightbulbs

- These are classified as hazardous waste and can be safely disposed of in receptacles at the entrance of your local Woolworths and Pick 'n Pay.

#### •Medical or Sanitary Products

- Sanitary wear, nappies or medical waste such as syringes (especially not with needles).

#### •Other

- Any plastics that have a triangle with the number 7 inside it.
