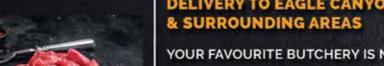

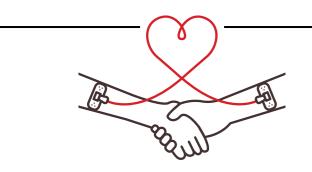

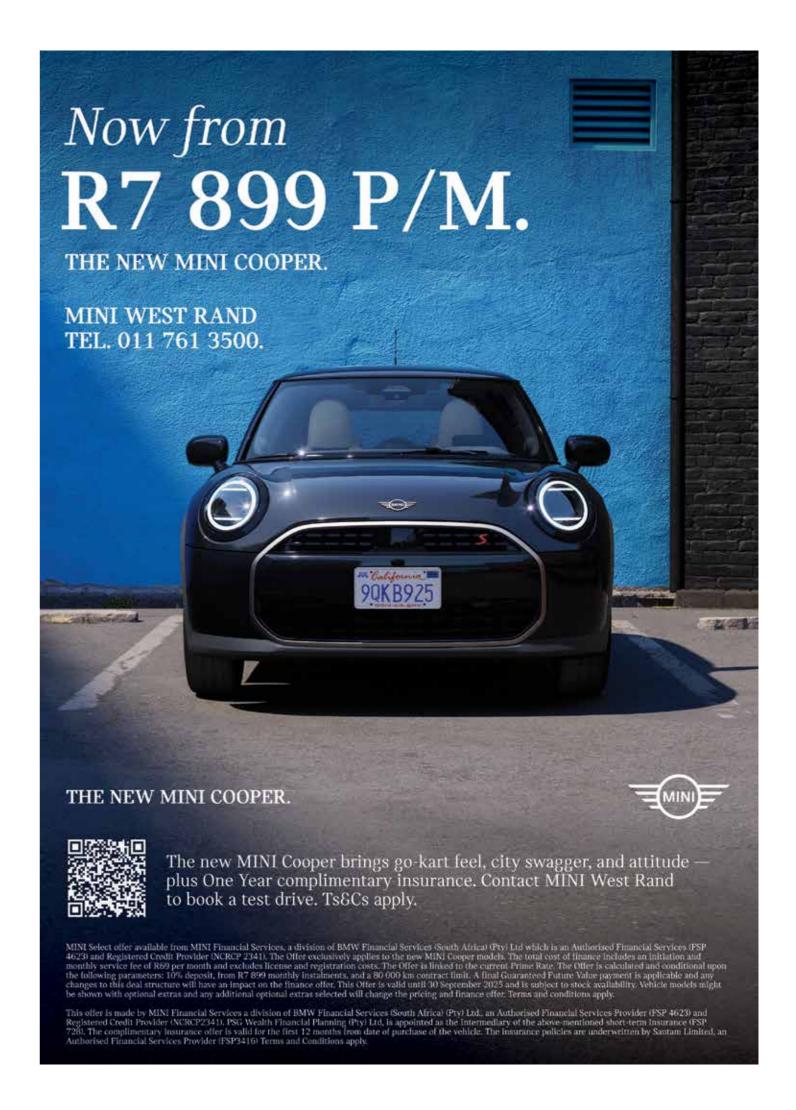

It's a Hoot

By now, you will have hopefully, seen or heard that we have two new residents who have moved into Eagle Canyon - our baby owls who were recently released.

Perched on one leg, head bent at an angle and a quizzical look from big eyes greeted. Perhaps our new residents are as curious about us as we are of them.

Eagle Canyon was recently selected to be a release site for abandoned or orphaned owls, and our first two baby Barn Owls moved into the estate on the 7th of July. They were just a month or so old, when they were discovered abandoned in a roof at home in Daveyton, making it loudly known that they were clearly unhappy with their predicament. The Germiston SPCA were called to rescue them and in turn, they were placed in the Owl Projects care.

Eagle Canyon has long been home to Barn Owls and Spotted-Eagle Owls, the two most common species here in Gauteng.

Our existing owl houses and bat hotels were in desperate need of servicing, and as we were undergoing this process at the time, we were approached by EcoSolutions Urban Ecology and the Owl Project to provide a home for the owlets.

The perfect spot was identified just off Muirfield road, in the dip behind the shuttle stop overlooking the dam. With a wooded area close by, and an existing owl box in the area, there was hope that this area would entice the owls to stick around once released. The owls needed to remain in a special release pen for 21 days before being released. During this time period, the owlets were required to be fed a diet of day-old chicks every evening and again to be checked the following morning to monitor their food intake. A request via our weekly Community Chatter newsletter was sent out for volunteers to assist in this special project, and a volunteer group was formed.

The babies were around two months old when they were brought to Eagle Canyon and placed in their special release pen. The arrived with much pomp and ceremony and again interested residents and the volunteer group were invited to watch as the owlets were released into their temporary home. Part of this process was the placing of rings around the legs of the owls, each with their own unique serial number, so that the owls can be tracked and identified in the future.

After 21 days, in the early hours of a chilly winter's morning, the pen was opened and the owls released. Food was provided for a time period giving the babies time to hunt and forage effectively and be able to fend for themselves.

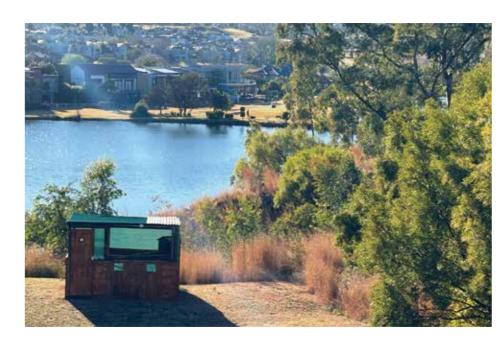
Residents are requested that if you observe any signs of owl activity, such as hearing calls, seeing an owl near one of the boxes or finding owl pellets, Sara and her team would love to hear about it.

Owl Boxes & Bat Hotels

We have eight owl boxes (five Spotted-Eagle Owl boxes and three Barn Owl Houses) as well as four bat hotels.

Owl Houses:

According to EcoSolutions ecologist Sara Orchardson, our estate provides excellent natural habitat for owls and bats, supported by mature trees, vegetation variety, and water sources. It was important to service the boxes ahead of the Spotted Eagle Owl breeding season, which began in July and runs through to November. As part of the service, nesting material was removed and gravel refreshed to support egg-laying behaviour. This pea-gravel substrate allows the Spotted Eagle Owls to mould a "cup" in which to lay their eggs and raise their young.

Barn Owls, on the other hand, breed between March and May as this is when rodent activity is higher. Interestingly the greater the abundance of prey, the greater number of eggs produced.

It is important that the owl boxes and bat houses are serviced on a yearly basis; as out of breeding season Egyptian Geese, other birds and Genets will move in. These visitors tend to bring sticks, paper and other debris into the box. Unless removed, owls will not use the boxes to breed in. The owl boxes were serviced by the EcoSolutions teams who assessed the structure and condition, replacing where necessary, removed nesting debris from other birds that may have used it; replenished the gravel in the Spotted Eagle Owl Boxes, waterproofed the boxes and treated the interiors to deter bee occupation.

The special release pen will remain permanent feature on the Estate, and we will remain part of the Owl Release Programme when required for abandoned and orphaned owls.

Bat Hotels:

Bats are agile and have an insatiable hunger for insects, with 70% of all bat species feasting on flies, mosquitoes, beetles and cockroaches. 100 bats will consume up to 60 000 insects a night – and with four bat hotels each able to house up to 300 bats; that's a lot of pest control! Plus, bats are responsible in assisting in the pollination of trees, flowers and cacti – making them extremely beneficial to our estate. The bat hotels were all replaced during the service, structures varnished and treated for bees.

Barn Owls - Tyto Alba

With their bright white heart-shaped faces facial discs, and dark inquisitive eyes shining out in the darkness, and high-pitched shriek, it is easy to see why barn owls often referred to as ghost owls.

Barn owls are immediately recognised by their heart-shaped facial discs. They are happy to live near people, and don't mind nesting in manmade structures (hence the importance of having owl boxes).

Barn owls are long winged and long legged with a short squarish tail. They grow to around 30cm to 33cm in length and have a wingspan of up to 110cm. Females weight around 365g, compared to males at 410g.

Both male and female are similar in colouration, with a golden brown upper body marked with grey wavy lines, and spotted black and white. The beak varies from pale pink to brownish horn. The underparts are white, with fine brown spots and the long legs are greyish brown. Barn owls have long wings and a short, squarish tail.

Barn owls fly almost silently, with comb-like structures at the edges of their wings (called serrations), which play a vital role in air-flow control and noise-reduction during flight.

Barn owls communicate with each other by various sounds, the most common of which are being the high-pitched screeching "schreeeeeee" sound, usually during flight. When courting, a hissing scream can be heard, accompanied by a shaking effect during flight. The male will also emit a low wail or purr to attract his chosen partner.

If they are frightened, or a predator is in the vicinity, the owls will issue a warning scream.

Barn owls love grasslands and wooded areas, and will inhabit tree cavities or man-made structures such as the wooden owl boxes which have been strategically placed. Barn owls create nests from regurgitated pellets.

As they are nocturnal, they will hunt for their food source once the sun has set, returning to their roost before sunrise. When hunting, they fly slowly to try and spot their prey, often using trees or high structures as a look-out. Their hunting tools include their ability to fly silently and their low-light/night vision and their ability to accurately localise sound. Their distinctive heart-shaped facial disk helps channel sound to their ear holes located beneath the feathers on each side of their face.

Barn owls provide a fantastic service as environmentally friendly pest control, as they feast on rats, mice and shrews, as well as small birds, insects, lizards, frogs and termites. Their prey is usually swallowed whole, with indigestible materials, such as bones and fur, regurgitated in the form of a pellet.

Sarah explains that part of EcoSolutions outreach is Junior Scientists Programme that is run through our school education initiative. The learners have an opportunity to dissect owl pellets and identify the bones to record which rodent species they find using a rodent skeleton key. EcoSolutions then submits this data to their National Owl Diet Database. The pellet dissection kits are labelled with coordinates from where the pellets are collected, and this information is fedback to the necessary, including farmers, to help them manage their rodent problems more effectively.

Barn Owls are both territorial and monogamous. They tend to mate for life (unless the loss of a partner through death). Despite this, a breeding pair may live separately outside of their breeding season, moving back into the area they have selected when it comes time to nest. As they are territorial, the breeding pair will often come back year after year to the same nesting site.

When it's time, the female will show interest by flying in circles around the area the couple have chosen as their nesting site. The male then joins, flying behind her while emitting high-pitched shrieks. This courtship dance can take place for 30 to 120 minutes. The female then lays multiple eggs, one egg every two days. She incubates the eggs for around a month, and they hatch in the same sequence in which they were laid.

During this time period, the male hunts for food, which he brings to feed his partner. Extra food is piled up next to her, to ensure adequate supply for the hatchlings. Once the eggs have hatched, both parents are responsible for feeding. At around a week old they are able to move around the next and can fledge around 55 days. Once they master their flying technique, the parents start reducing the amount of food given, to encourage them to hunt for themselves.

Did you know?

Barn owls have developed smart strategies to protect against animal predators, as they hiss loudly when a predator is nearby. This confuses the predator, which mistakes the owl for another animal. They also practise "tonic immobility" whereby they lie very still pretending to be dead, the predator then loses interest.

Rodent Control and Our Estate Wildlife

Unfortunately, the barn owl's biggest predator is humans, who put out poisoned bait to kill rodents, which in turn, can result in secondary poisoning of the owls who eat the dead or dying rodents

Eagle Canyon is home to owls, feral cats, mongoose and more – all of which help with rodent control. And all of which run the risk of being poisoned should the wrong rodenticides or insecticides be utilised. Barn owls are considered to be particularly excellent for rodent control, with a breeding pair consuming around 80kg of rodents annually.

The Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development have issued a formal

notice regarding three rodenticides that are now banned in South Africa due to their high toxicity and long-term environment and health risks.

Banned Active Ingredients (Rodenticides):

- Brodifacoum
- Coumatetralyl
- Difenacoum

These active ingredients are found in a range of commonly used commercial rodenticide products, including but not limited to:

- Brodifacoum: Klerat, Talon, Havoc, Final, Jaguar, Rodex (blocks, grain, pellets, liquid and pasta bait)
- Coumatetralyl: Racumin, Ratex, Couma

• **Difenacoum:** Neosorexa, Sorexa, Rodex Raptor, Muskil, Storm Secure

These compounds have been widely used in rodent control but pose a substantial risk to humans, non-target wildlife (including owls and other predators), and the broader ecosystem. Their inclusion on this banned list reflects growing awareness and commitment to safer, more sustainable pest control practices.

Should you have the need for rodent control, we request that you transition to compliant, non-toxic rodent management systems that align with both legal requirements and environmental best practice, as well as being safe for our Estate wildlife - including our baby owls!

Spring Up Your Space

As the winter chill starts to fade it's that time of the year again to declutter, refresh and revive.

Invest in house plants

Now is the time to refresh those household plants. Research shows that a ratio of one plant to three people in a home improves air quality and reduces the amount of dust by up to 50%. Plants, such as lavender, snake plant, peace lily and aloe vera are just some of the plants that can assist in reducing stress and anxiety, due to their calming scents and air-purifying properties.

Plants also have the ability to improve your productivity. Studies have shown that plants in your indoor environment can increase your productivity by up to 15%, even if you are in a stressful or pressurised environment. Another (small) study had students in a classroom environment with either a fake plant, a real one, a photograph of a plant or no plant at all. Brain scans of the participants revealed that those students who studied with live plants in the classroom were more attentive and better able to concentrate than the others.

37% reduction in anxiety

58% reduction in feelings of depression 44% reduction in anger or hostility

38% reduction in feeling tired or fatigue.

Grow your own salad

As the winter chill starts to ebb and the days warm up, it's time to ditch those winter soups and stews and make way for fresh, vibrant and healthy salads

And what better way than to grow your own? Not only do you get the psychological and physical benefits of gardening (such as exercise, stress

reduction and an increase of those feel good serotonin hormones) but gardening also provides an inspiring and creative outlet.

Start prepping from mid-August, by identifying and clearing your prime areas based on your needs and available space. Patty pans, squash and cucumber all need space to spread, while compact areas are suitable for leafy greens, such as spinach and lettuce, as while as beetroot, cabbage and leeks.

Herbs, cherry tomatoes, chillies, beans and peas all grow well in pots or veggie boxes if you have limited growing space.

Beans, beetroot, carrot, celery, cucumber, lettuce, corn, parsnip, peas, peppers, radish, pumpkin, tomatoes, spinach Swiss chard and spekboom.

Clean up your kitchen and bathrooms

"The two biggest places that germs reside in are the kitchen and the bathroom. So, you want to make sure you clean those two areas really well. And I'm talking about the high touch surfaces like light switches, faucets, door handles," says Dr Neya Vyas, a family medicine physician at Cleveland Clinic, USA.

"In the bathroom, you've got your toilet handles, you've got your toothbrush. In the kitchen, you have your kitchen sink, you've got your appliances, especially like your cutting board."

Dr Vyas adds that depending on the type of germs invading your space, they can live up to 48 hours or even longer!

According to the National Sanitation Foundation (NSF.org), areas where food is stored or prepared has more bacteria than any other place in your home

Your kitchen sponge, used to clean dishes and countertops, has been found to be one of the most germ-ridden spots in your home.

Research shows that your kitchen sponge can be a breeding zone for bacteria – with Italian scientists reporting that your common dish sponge was the "most contaminated item in the household and an ideal habitat for microorganisms and foodborne pathogens."





As kitchen sponges are a relatively inexpensive item, regularly replacement (weekly or biweekly) is the best way to keep a hygienic kitchen space.

However, the rule of thumb is that if the kitchen sponge has an odour, throw it away. Immediately. An odour means that the sponge is already a breeding ground for bacteria. The biggest problem is that unless the sponge completely dries out between uses, it can become a hotbed for germs such as foodborne illness pathogens, mold and yeast.

Better options for cleaning are dishcloths as these can be washed and sanitised. Ideally you should replace your washable cloths, and dish towels every one to two days.

The second highest concentration of germs was found in your kitchen sink, reports NSF. Disinfect your sink once or twice a week, using a good kitchen disinfecting cleaner. Alternatively wipe down with a diluted bleach solution.

Scarily, the third highest concentration of germs was found on the toothbrush holder. If your toothbrush holder is dishwasher safe, wash once or twice a week. If not, it is recommended that you wash with soapy

water and use a disinfected wipe once or twice a week.

Your pets bowl ranks number four on the germ scale, and again the NSF recommends that these be washed daily.

If you have a coffee machine, the coffee reservoir is considered the fifth highest germ collector. Being dark and damp, this is a prime location for bacteria and mildew to grow. It is recommended you clean out the unit every 40 to 80 brew cycles or monthly (whichever comes first).

Faucet handles in both the kitchen and bathroom are rated sixth on the germ list, with research showing faucet handles containing coliform bacteria, yeast and mould. Try to clean daily with a disinfectant cleaner or wipes.

Pet toys, while providing hours of fun, are also a haven for hidden lurgies. NSF suggests you encourage family members to wash hands after playing with your pets (particularly before eating). Hard or plastic toys can be cleaned with hot soapy water and rinsed with fresh water, while soft toys can be tossed into the washing with the other laundry. It is recommended that these are washed monthly (or more often if necessary).

Research reveals that coliform bacteria was found in around 30% of countertops tested, the source of which can be linked to unwashed fresh produce, raw meal and poultry. It also can be through pet dishes and pet toys left on the kitchen counters. Once you have finished food prep, it is recommended you clean with kitchen disinfectant and rinse with clean water. This should be done daily or after each meal prep.

Number nine on the germ list is one you may not have considered – your stove knobs. Clean these once a week (or more often, if required after an enthusiastic cooking session!)

Last on the hidden lurgy list is your cutting boards. This is because cutting boards may be used for different foods, and it is important to wash these thoroughly after each use or between different food types. Alternatively, invest in different coloured boards for different food types.

So, spring into action (and health) this season – getting you ready to face the last quarter of this year with vigour.

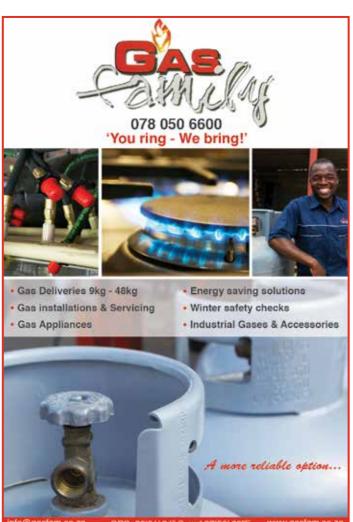

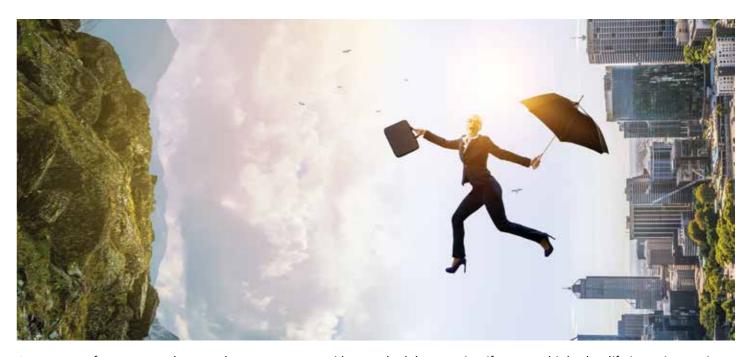

Survival Skills in an Upside-Down World

"Life doesn't get easier or more forgiving. We get stronger and more resilient." - Wayne Dyer



At recent conferences or other speaker engagements, I have asked the question if anyone thinks that life is getting easier... Not once did someone give me a positive response to this question. Why? Because, simply, life is definitely not getting easier, and as Steve Maraboli points out, we need to get stronger and more resilient by acquiring relevant "survival skills".

When I refer to survival skills, I am not referring to survival hard skills like securing shelter, finding or creating a water source or obtaining food. Instead, I am referring to soft skills, which I believe will assist us in becoming more resilient to face the challenges that life throws at us, now more than ever.

Survival Skill #1 - Take Charge

When I wrote "Conquering my NeMEsis", the first chapter of the book was titled Taking Charge, I am a firm believer in the fact that we don't take charge enough to facilitate positive change in our lives and the lives of the people around us. This is something I also see very often when I do leadership coaching sessions. We underestimate the extent to which we can take charge. We can only create the life we want if we truly take charge of all aspects of our lives as much as we possibly can, even if this means that we need to make tough decisions.

We also need to be intentional about the things we do... Otherwise, we'll be like a floating wine cork on the surface of the sea, being pushed from pillar to post by other people or circumstances. Finally, taking charge also means that I don't compare myself with anyone else than with the best version of me. If I compare myself with anyone else, then I allow myself to be distracted from being the best version of me.

Survival Skill #2 Start with Self

As I am writing this article, I am sitting on an aeroplane returning home from a local business

trip. I was just told in the safety briefing to, in

the case of an emergency, put the oxygen mask

If I look after my own wellbeing first, is it not selfish, you might ask? The answer is "NO". The reality is that we cannot pour from an empty cup, and if we only focus on the survival of others, we will not survive and also cause those people who are dependent on us to suffer as a result.

Survival Skill #3

- Become more Vulnerable

We as men, are as especially guilty of the fact that we don't talk when it's necessary to talk. That's one of the main reasons why roughly, four times more men commit suicide than women. Pride is a killer... literally. There is no sense in refusing to speak up if you are battling to survive, not realising that it's okay to not be okay.

I am not, for one second, saying that you must weep uncontrollably every day in sharing your innermost secrets, but I would suggest that you find an accountability partner whom you can trust with your feelings, to share and ask for advice, if and when needed. In saying this, don't underestimate the liberating feeling of just sharing your burdens with a trusted companion. Someone for whom you can play the same role in a reciprocal, mutually beneficial, relationship.

Survival Skill #4

Improve Personal Productivity

Given life's increased demands on us, I have found that by increasing my personal productivity, I am not only able to achieve more, but it also provides me with an increased sense of being more in control of my life. I can attest to the fact that this is an amazing feeling.

Being more focused; delegating effectivel; being able to say "No"; procrastinating less; using time blocks effectively; prioritising tasks; dealing with e-mails effectively; and just being more disciplined in general, are all effective ways of improving our personal productivity. By doing this, we effectively free up time and, as a result, we feel less overwhelmed and more on top of things, which assists us in surviving much more easily.

Survival Skill #5

- Charge your "Life Batteries"

I use a concept that I coined, "life batteries". These are activities that provide me with a sense of peace, and which I need to do frequently to destress. When I am less stressed, it simply increases my resiliency, and I have much more strength to manage life's challenges. By

charging my life batteries, I am much more equipped to survive...

The things that charge my life batteries include cardiovascular exercise (like swimming and jogging), spending time in the bush, mindfulness meditation and taking quality time off with my family. We are all unique, and for you, these life battery charging activities will probably differ. Whatever it is, I would like to encourage you to identify these activities and to do more of them in order to find it easier to cope.

Survival Skill #6 - Find Balance

You might be familiar with the "Wheel of Life" concept, which is a visual representation of different life areas, allowing us to rate our satisfaction in each and identify areas needing more attention. By visualising the balance (or imbalance) in different areas like your career, relationships with family and friends, health, and personal growth, it helps us to set goals and work towards a more fulfilling life.

Think of this wheel as a bicycle wheel, where each area in which you would like to achieve future success is represented by a spoke on this wheel. Now, let's assume that you don't have any balance in life and you only focus on work, day in and day out. Imagine how this wheel would be moving forward with only one spoke... It simply would not be able to operate properly.

If you then lose your job, for argument's sake, and the only spoke you had broke, then you would not have a wheel at all. If you have

balance, though, by also spending quality time on the other areas of your life, then you will have enough areas in your life that will assist you to survive mentally and physically, if one of your spokes had to break, such as losing your job.

Survival Skill #7 - Adapt

The well known saying "adapt or die" does not mean that we necessarily need to accept the new realities that we are faced with in life. It simply means that we need to adapt or adjust to them to survive. Otherwise, on a personal level, we will potentially become like Kodak, which did not embrace digital photography or BlackBerry, which was too slow to adopt touchscreen technology and underestimated the growing App ecosystem.

"It is not the strongest of the species that survives, nor the most intelligent. It is the one that is most adaptable to change." - Charles Darwin

If we don't, for example, embrace emerging technologies like Artificial Intelligence (AI) in our careers and personal lives, then we will fall behind and inhibit our ability to survive. Why? Simply, because in a very competitive world, we need to explore and implement anything and everything possible, to make the best of the situation that we find ourselves in, including the achievement of our goals. That is, of course, assuming that it's legally, morally and ethically acceptable.

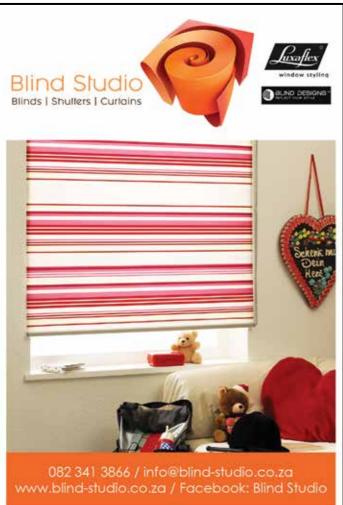
