## LOCAL RULES



We highlight the next three rules in today's edition:

**8. Practice:** No practising whatsoever is allowed on the golf course. At no stage may a player play more than one ball except as provided under the rules of golf.

**9. Caddies:** Caddy fees will be published on the notice Boards and can change from time to time. It is in the interest of golfers to only use registered caddies. Identification bibs/uniforms will be issued to registered caddies. A Caddy is highly recommended.

**10. Handicaps:** Handicaps are calculated as determined by SAGU. Queries can be directed to the Golf Committee. Members not submitting a score, in accordance with the rules laid down by the SAGU, after completion of 9/18 holes of golf will have a penalty score recorded at the next handicap provision.

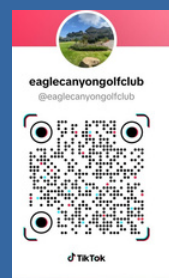
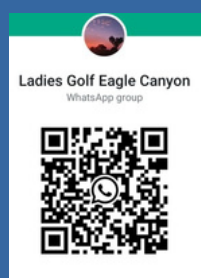
