(Gaston Aquatics)

2026-2027 Contract

This is a binding contract in which you are agreeing to pay the complete amount of dues owed by July 1, 2027. Regardless of start date; this contract is for the entire year (any proration is subject to approval by the Director of Operations and Director of Competitive Swimming).

Dues outline: (Dues does not include registration fee that will be charged upon completing this registration (as outlined in registration agreement)

Dues will begin drafting on Oct 1, 2026. If you wish to make a one time payment it will be processed on that date.

Families with more than one swimmer are eligible for a reduction in rates. Reduction is credited to the lowest cost swimmer.

Dues Payment Options:

- **One time payment due Oct 1, 2026.** (Via ACH or Credit/Debit Card) (Oct 1st)
or
- **10 Monthly installments due on the 1st of Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan, Feb, Mar, Apr, May, Jun, July** (Online billing will process on the last day of the preceding month) (Via ACH or Credit/Debit Card)

Your Obligations:

1. Have a payment method on file that allows you to pay all dues on time. **Expired, removed, or insufficient payment methods that cause dues to be past due will be assessed a \$25 late fee on 15th of the month.** Swimmers may not be allowed to practice or attend meets if accounts are delinquent. Dues are required whether or not your swimmer competes outside of the Gator Home Meets and includes the Entire Season (September through the following July)
2. Dues may only be waived at the discretion of the Operations Director and the Director of Competitive Swimming. This would include special circumstances or illness that make it impossible for the swimmer to complete the program. Exceptions must be formally requested to the Directors in a timely manner and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
3. Have your swimmer at practice at least **5 minutes before practice starts** and **10 minutes before warm-ups starts at a meet.**
4. Say YES to calls for volunteers. We host two meets per year and conduct various fundraising/special activities that require the support of all the families. Signing this contract commits your time as a volunteer and at a minimum you must volunteer to work at all Gator hosted meets. Swimmers Accounts will be assessed a \$50 penalty per meet for lack of volunteering during one meet session.
5. Swimmers/Parents will be asked to leave the team if their conduct is disruptive to practice or other operations of the team.
6. **Swimmers must wear team suits and caps** (if a cap is worn). Failure to comply with this will result in 1 warning and then suspension from competition. A plain black suit may be worn in some cases. (Tech Suits will be allowed with Coach's Approval at certain meets (Black, Gray, Green or White ONLY)
