RETURN OF "THE CUP" AT MASSES Started on Holy Thursday, Apr 17

The *Feast of the Supper of the Lord* on Holy Thursday was the return of *The Cup of the Precious Blood of Christ* to our Eucharistic celebration.

<u>Please note</u>: The stations for the Eucharistic Bread will be a sharp right or left along the front pew. The Cup will be in the middle. After receiving the Eucharistic Bread, you may continue to your seat, or, go first to The Cup to receive the Precious Blood, and then go to your seat.

How to Receive from The Cup: Approach the Minister with the *The Cup* and respond "Amen" when they say "The Blood of Christ." Take the cup and then take a sip, and then hand it back. "Intincture," that is dipping the Eucharistic Bread into the Wine, is not allowed in our diocese and the Minister of The Cup will not allow you to do so.
