

ALL SOULS DAY Sunday, Nov 2

All Saints Day falls on a Saturday this year, which means it is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year. Since we don't have daily Masses on Saturdays, the feast day is 'skipped' this year.

All Souls Day falls on a Sunday this year, and it replaces the Sunday Mass of Ordinary Time. The Saturday evening and Sunday morning Masses will all be All Souls Day Masses.

At this time of year, we hold a Memorial Mass for our parishioners (or their loved ones) who died in the past year. We invite their family and friends to attend a Memorial Mass in which we pray for them by name and those attending light a candle for them.

If your loved one passed this past year and the funeral rites were celebrated elsewhere, please come. Arrive about 10 minutes early and give us the name of that person and we will announce them with the others. The memorial Masses will take place on:

- Saturday, Nov 1, 10a for Precious Blood
- Tuesday, Nov 4, 7 PM for St. Dorothea
