What does this all mean?

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII declared the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which the Church celebrates every year on August 15. Simply put, the dogma of the Assumption states that at the end of her life, the Blessed Virgin Mary was taken, body and soul, into Heaven.

While this event isn't reflected in Sacred Scripture, it is clearly part of the Church's earliest observance. In the sixth century, St. John Damascene wrote in one of his sermons, "Your sacred and happy soul, as nature will have it, was separated in death from your most blessed and immaculate body, and although the body was duly interred, it did not remain in the state of death, neither was it dissolved by decay; your most pure and sinless body was not left on earth, but you were transferred to your heavenly throne."

Theologically speaking, death is often understood to be a consequence of original sin. Since Mary was conceived without Original Sin, some theologians have wondered if Mary died or if perhaps she was taken into Heaven without experiencing death. The Catechism of the Catholic Church doesn't answer this question but simply states, "The most blessed Virgin Mary, when the course of her earthly life was completed, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven" (no. 974)

The Solemnity of the Assumption reminds us of the unique role that Mary served in the process of our salvation. Although she was without sin, we have the possibility of receiving God's forgiveness for our sins through Christ. Her entry into Heaven prefigures our own hope of experiencing the same eternal life. Ordinarily, the celebration of the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a holy day of obligation for Catholics, but when it falls on a Saturday or a Monday, that obligation to attend Mass is lifted.

WHAT IS THE ASSUMPTION?

The first name of this solemnity was the Feast of Mary, Mother of God. Later, its name in the East carried over, the Dormition (or Falling Asleep) of Mary. In the West, it became known as the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

This solemnity celebrates the fact that Mary's Assumption is "a pledge of the future participation of the members of the mystical Body of Christ in the paschal glory of the Risen Christ." It shows that the Lord "reserves a munificent reward for his humble Servant because of her faithful cooperation with the divine plan, which is a destiny of fullness, happiness, glorification of her immaculate soul, her virginal body, perfect configuration to her Risen Son" (Directory, no. 180). The Mass has a proper vigil, and the solemnity replaces the Mass of the day when it



Redwoods, Soul Food, and Stargazing - Summer Camp, On-Demand

Cloaked by gentle morning dew on her sleeping bag, 11-year-old Catholic Charities CYO Camper, Rosita, opens her eyes. The sense of community and safety she feels after a night sleeping in the open air next to her cabin buddies makes her content this morning.

The night before, she and her six other cabin buddies - a "household" (to reduce the potential of COVID transmission) - were chatting around a campfire. From the outside, it looked like any other campfire gathering. But inside this circle, a deep **community warmth** radiated among the group. After an incredibly difficult year that left not one pocket of the world unaffected by COVID-19, here there was an undeniable shift in perspective on what it means to **share the same air under the stars at night**. CYO Camp enforces ample protocols to ensure as safe an experience as possible for all. Staff and campers get tested upon arrival and then again on their fourth day. All staff have been fully vaccinated since April 2021.

This summer, the program has led with an emphasis on community building after a year of isolation. Rick Garcia, Director of Catholic Charities CYO Camp, says, "while it's great the kids are able to do traditional camp activities again, what's been the most special to witness are the profound connections they have made." The opportunity for social, physical, and mental stimulation also helps kids to decompress after the communal stress of the previous year. It is a time of reconnecting with the earth, each other, and themselves while feeling safe and grounded.


