SYNOD OF BISHOPS ON SYNODALITY

Pope Francis invites the whole Church to participate in the preparatory process for the upcoming Synod of Bishops on Synodality. This unprecedented opportunity will facilitate discussion and reflection to help shape the Church's understanding of herself and her mission of evangelization and forming disciples.

The Archdiocese of San Francisco will kick-off the local synodal process this month of January by asking every Catholic to participate in the **Disciple Marker Index** survey. The process will continue in February and March with engagement sessions offered throughout the Archdiocese. The Disciple Marker Index survey is a nationally recognized survey administered at parishes around the United States and Canada since 2013 by the Catholic leadership Institute. The results from this survey will provide baseline feedback from which content for engagement sessions will be developed. More details are available through the Archdiocese website at www.sfarch.org/synod

Critical to this process is the Parish Contact Point Person for the Archdiocese. **Rita Liu**, coordinator of the parish Hospitality, was so kind to accept this position. Initial steps are underway. A meeting is set to present and discuss these initial steps with the Parish Pastoral Council on January 11th. The parish Communications Ministry, headed by Vivian and along with her colleagues, Estelle Oloresisimo and Rita herself, will also be valuable in this process.

Please stay tuned for more information on the kick-off of the synodal process in our parish through the **Disciple Marker Index** survey.

In the meantime, let's pray for the success of this indispensable endeavor for the future of our beloved Church.

BAPTISMAL DEATH AND RESURRECTION

As we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, we also honor our own baptism as our initiation into the Christian life and community. In the Gospel, the baptism of Jesus, with his immersion and then emergence from the water, points to his later submission to God at his death, and his emergence from the grave at his resurrection. This pattern of death and resurrection is our path too, as followers of Jesus. Throughout life, often in small ways, we learn to surrender our limited and self-centered agendas. This surrender often feels like death. The sacrament of Baptism ritually enacts this pattern to remind us of Jesus' death and resurrection, so that we too might embrace the deaths and resurrections of our own lives. As Jesus emerged from the water, he encountered his Father and the Holy Spirit. Like Jesus, we can know we are God's beloved, empowered by the Spirit.
