

### WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY **JANUARY 18 - 25**

## The DMI Survey is now open!

The *Disciple Maker Index* (DMI) survey for St. Augustine Parish is now open until February 14, and it can be completed both online and as a hardcopy survey that can be filled out in-person and submitted to the Parish Office by February 13. The DMI Survey is an anonymous survey that allows an individual to reflect upon their faith journey (spiritual growth and discipleship), as well as how much one is journeying (participation) with the parish. Your participation in this unprecedented worldwide consultation, guided by the Holy Spirit, is an opportunity to share your voice which may impact the future of the Universal Church.

### Step 1: Complete the DMI Survey now.

A few things to consider:

- 1. Complete the entire survey all in one sitting (may take 10-15 minutes).
- 2. There are no right or wrong answers.

### Reflection on the Prayer for Christian Unity

The prayer for Christian unity that Father Ray strongly advocates for our community of faithful to recite during mass from January 18-25 is indeed perfect timing for the launch of the diocesan phase of the Synodal process at St. Augustine. The week of prayer for Christian unity invites us to reflect and ponder on the symbolism of the three wise men, otherwise known as the Magi, who did not know each other as they came from faraway places but they eventually converged and traveled together by following the star that led them to the newborn Jesus. They represent unity in diversity. In our modern world "unity in diversity" is what is being asked of us by our Holy Father, Pope Francis in the Synod for Synodality. All Christians are invited to pray for unity and continue to journey together, said Cardinals Mario Grech, general secretary of the Synod of the Bishops, and Cardinal Kurt Koch, president of the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity.

The current pandemic is a disruptive experience for the church and the world. We find ourselves having to navigate unfamiliar terrain without a clear map. We feel lost in a wilderness but like the three Magi, we will find our way if we hold on to each other and collectively create a path for Christians from various denominations to journey and grow together in solidarity with the poor and those in the peripheries of our society and be truly disciples of Jesus.

In the Synod, Pope Francis is asking each one of us to listen deeply to our neighbors and not just talk at them. In a joint statement, Cardinals Grech and Koch said: "Conscious of our need for the accompaniment and the many gifts of our brothers and sisters in Christ, we call on them to journey with us during these two years and we sincerely pray that Christ will lead us closer to him and so to one another." Both of them have been focusing on ways the local churches can implement an ecumenical dimension of the synodal process given that "synodality and ecumenism are processes of walking together."

### California Mortgage Relief Program Up to \$80,000 in Mortgage Relief for Qualified Applicants

The State of California recently launched a mortgage relief program to help homeowners who fall behind on mortgage payments due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Eligible households can quality for up to \$80,000 in relief for their past due housing-related bills. The payments will be made directly to the homeowner's mortgage provider. Homeowners will **NOT** need to repay the state for funds received. The State has set aside \$1 billion for this program through the American Rescue Plan that was passed in March 2021. To find out if you are eligible for the program and to apply, please visit CaMortgageRelief.org. For homeowners who do not have access to a computer or internet, you can contact your mortgage provider or call a HUD-certified housing counselor at 1-800-569-4287. There is no deadline to apply for this program as the program will end once all funds are exhausted.

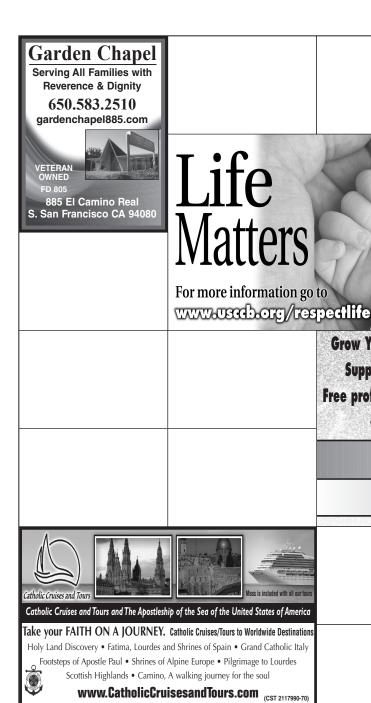

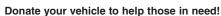


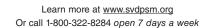
