LOVE AS GOD LOVES

Our Gospel today continues Jesus' Sermon on the Plain, in which we heard Luke's version of the Beatitudes. This week, Jesus gives us new "commandments," telling us how to live and act in the world as his disciples, rooted in the radical love of God for humanity. It reminds us of his later speech about loving one another as he loves us, in other words with a God-like love, the kind we see in today's psalm about God's mercy. How else could we do as Jesus tells us by loving our enemies, which seems impossible, until we remember that God gave us the example of Jesus, who is like God but also like us? David understands this merciful love when he spares the life of his enemy in the first reading. Finally, Paul tells us that we will become like Jesus if we act as he did, as God does. Copyright © J. CHURCH MAINTENANCE UPDATE IN SAINT AUGUSTINE PARISH

SACRISTY. Existing wood laminate flooring in the Sacristy, which was damaged by the August 2021 bursting of water pipe at the Chapel, is now being replaced with cement tile flooring.

TRIANGULAR STAINED GLASS ABOVE

THE SANCTUARY. Of historical significance, this is a beautiful part of the original church structure built in 1975. There are many hundreds of small pieces of different shapes and colors of glass comprising the whole facade grouped together in individual sub-frames that represent the 12 apostles. Those individual sub-frames are attached to the main frame with its edges sealed with glazing putty for a watertight fit. As those putty have duration for its effectiveness, normal wear and tear took its toll and caused water leaks. As it occurred, progressive preventive measures were done. It came to a point that the problem need to be addressed as a whole, rather than on a piece-meal basis. The complicated work of restoring this historic triangular stained glass will commence soon.

EXISTING TREES BY THE NORTH SIDE PERIMETER OF THE CHURCH PROPERTY.

These trees were planted when the church was originally constructed.
Through the years, majority of these trees have grown and their invasive roots have caused damage on the immediate neighbor's garage as well as on the concrete sidewalk between the church property and the adjacent town homes. Bids are now being solicited for cutting those full grown trees, about 13 of them.







