St. Joseph's Feast Day

St. Joseph's Fiesta at St. Augustine Parish If ever there's a need for proof that evangelizing the culture can enrich parish life, we need not look further. The fiesta-like celebration of the Feast of St. Joseph at St. Augustine this past weekend was a joyous celebration of the tradition of the St. Joseph's Table (Tavola) that had its origins in a Sicilian legend from the Middle Ages that attributes the end of a devastating drought to a prayer-devotion that the Sicilian people made to St. Joseph. Italian immigrants brought this religious and cultural practice with them to the United States.

Prior to the pandemic, the Italian Catholic Federation #213 hosted an annual parish community meal laid on a beautifully decorated long table-altar at St. Augustine parish hall wherein everyone was welcomed. This year, with pandemic still lingering, ICF distributed colorful paper bags filled with assorted food items and prayer cards. Check out the Fava bean included in the bag. It is a symbol of good luck!

Last year, amid the pandemic restrictions enforced by the government, the newly organized St. Joseph Ministry at St. Augustine resuscitated St. Joseph's celebration by inviting parish families to build their own table-altar and fill it with bread and food for the family to partake. This year, they also spearheaded another parish-wide food drive with all proceeds donated to the Samaritan House serving the entire San Mateo County.

Indeed, St. Augustine parish is so blessed to have various ministries and parishioners working together and participating in community parish life. After the 9:00 AM Mass, many parishioners joined Father Ray Reyes in the procession that culminated in the blessing of the new Shrine of St. Joseph. Thanks to the generosity of Rolly and Shirlyn Bautista for donating the beautiful statue of Saint Joseph and to all ministries and parishioners who contributed food and made it possible to have a wonderful celebration.
